The Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League in all its activities, is fully committed to the principles of equality of opportunity in cricket, and to ensuring that its officials, member clubs and all other individuals working or volunteering for the League, and participating in or watching League activities, are treated fairly and are able to conduct their activities free from discrimination, harassment or intimidation.

The League's Equity & Diversity Group is seeking to expand its membership and invites expressions of interest from potential new members.

The Group's vision statement is:

'To have a zero-tolerance policy to racism and all discrimination in the game of cricket in the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League, whilst being an example to other leagues and networks within the game. To drive diversity and equality within cricket, and to make cricket an equitable and diverse game for all.'

The group's aim is to have as diverse a membership as possible so that it can fully represent all backgrounds and beliefs.

Purpose of the Equity & Diversity Group

- To provide representation to the YCSPL on issues, challenges and opportunities regarding equity and diversity
- To be a recognised stakeholder group that the YCSPL League committee can consult and collaborate with on strategy, action plans and resources.
- To advocate and model good practice in equity and diversity to ensure that it fits within both the ECB and YCSPL aims and objectives.
- To work in collaboration with the ECB, YCB and YCSPL to support the development and implementation of any initiatives across all leagues.
- To build strong relationships between all communities, ECB, counties, clubs, and the cricket network
- To use cricket to make a positive difference to communities and bring the game together as one

Commitment

- To be available to attend (mainly online) one meeting per month maximum out of the cricket season, and one bi-monthly meeting maximum within the cricket season
- To attend where required additional and relevant other YCSPL meetings representing the group – approximately one per month maximum
- To be available to discuss and meet and/or respond at short notice to discuss, collaborate, and provide comment and direction to the YCSPL on relevant matters arising from cricket under its jurisdiction
