Chairman's introduction

I welcome everyone to our matchday handbook for our fourth season as a league.

After having only 37 out of 1,364 league games cancelled or abandoned in 2022, this figure rocketed to 392 last year –the wettest summer since 2012.

One of my priorities for last season was improving discipline. Despite the fact that umpires were encouraged to report players where necessary, the number of players reported in 2023 represented only a very small percentage of those playing in the League. We must not be complacent though, and we will retain a focus on this issue in 2024.

Other than discipline, and continuing to work to improve standards throughout the League, our main priorities for the coming season are:

- ensuring that we get buy-in from all our clubs into our new strategy for the much-needed recruitment of officials, without whom we do not have a game
- working with the Women's & Girls' League towards more fully integrating them into our structure
- encouraging clubs from the Senior Section to make use of our Development Fund for small projects to improve facilities

Finally, I would like to thank our sponsors Nicholas Associates, K3 Dental, Readers and Tiflex for their continued support.

I hope that everyone connected with our league, players, officials and spectators, will have an enjoyable season and that the sun will shine on us more than it did in 2023. I hope to see as many of you as possible in the coming months.

League playing conditions 2024

- 1 **General.** These playing conditions will apply to all league games played in the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League. Unless otherwise stated below, all games will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game, the Spirit of Cricket, and any current ECB directives.
- 2 **Changes to these playing conditions.** Either the relevant cricket committee or clubs may propose changes, which will be voted upon at the AGM by clubs in membership of the appropriate section for the following season. Clubs must notify any proposals for changes to the head of the relevant section no later than 31 August, in order to ensure that they can be properly considered and notice given to clubs.
- 3 **Teams.** All clubs shall play their strongest possible team that is eligible to play in that competition in all games. Teams must be selected in line with the Spirit of Cricket and players from a higher division must not be selected to play in a lower division team to strengthen that team. No game will start unless a minimum of seven nominated players from each side are present on the ground.
- 4 **Start of play**
 - i. *Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2.* Unless ground or weather conditions do not permit, all games will commence at 12.00 noon. If play has not started by 15.00 hours, an early tea should be taken at that point. An early tea can be taken at any time if both captains so agree. No game will start after 16.35.
 - ii. *Divisions 3 to 9.* Unless ground or weather conditions do not permit, games will commence at 13.00 hours. In addition, if play has not started within two and a half hours of the scheduled start time, the game will be cancelled.
 - iii. Where three or more members of a team are delayed in arriving at a ground for a bona fide and unavoidable reason, then the start of the game may be delayed, at the request of their team captain, by up to two hours. In this case, the number of overs to be played shall not be reduced until after one hour has been lost, and there will be a deduction of four overs for every complete 15 minutes lost thereafter.

5 Duration of play

Premier Section

- i. The normal duration of play will be 50 overs per side, unless reduced due to ground or weather conditions under paras 5.ii or 13.i. Any unused overs in the first innings will not be carried forward into the second innings. In order to achieve a result, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 20 overs.
- ii. Where bad weather is anticipated later in the day, duration of the game may be reduced, if both captains so agree before the toss is made. Both captains must agree on the new number of overs to be played, which shall not be less than 20. The provisions of rule 13 will continue to apply, and for a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 20 overs.

Senior Section

- iii. Unless reduced due to ground or weather conditions, the normal duration of play will be:
 - *Divisions 1 & 2* - 50 overs per side
 - *Divisions 3 to 5* - 46 overs per side
 - *Divisions 6 to 9* - 40 overs per side
- iv. Any unused overs in the first innings will not be carried over into the second innings.
- v. In games where 30 minutes or more are lost after the start due to weather conditions, a timed cut-off point will apply. For games in Divisions 3 to 5, play can continue until 19:50; for games in Divisions 6 to 9, play can continue until 19:10pm. These times include the 30-minute extension provided for in 13.v. After these cut-off times, play will cease at the end of the over in progress, unless a result is achieved before then. If a result has not been achieved before these times, then the count back-system (para 19.ii) will be used. Stoppages totalling less than 30 minutes will have no effect on the agreed overs to be bowled.

- vi. Where bad weather is anticipated later in the day, duration of the game may be reduced, if both captains so agree, before the toss is made. Both captains must agree on the new number of overs to be played, in accordance with 13 iv & v. The provisions of rule 12.i will also continue to apply, and for a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 20 overs.

6 Teams

- i *Minimum number of players*
 - a. A minimum of seven players shall be required to constitute a team. If a side has less than seven players, they will be deemed to have conceded the fixture.
 - b. Clubs playing less than 11 players in games in the In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2 may incur the maximum permitted fine and a points deduction.
 - c. In the event that a club cannot field 11 players in all of its fixtures on a particular day, then a lower team must not field more than or equal to the number of players in the higher team (for example, if the club has 19 players available, they may play 11 in the first team and eight in the second team, or 10 in the first team and nine in the second team; if there are 30 players available for a club that has three teams, then they may play 11 in the first team and 11 in the Second team, and eight in the third team; or 11 in the first team, 10 in the second team, and nine in the third team).
- ii *Late arrival of players.* The provisions of the Laws of the Game (24 and 25) will apply in the In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2. In Divisions 3 to 9, any player arriving late may take a full part in the game. Immediately on the arrival of the late player, the captain must inform the umpire of their arrival.

7 Toss, nomination of players and pre-match meeting

- i. *Toss.* The toss will take place at a pre-match meeting between captains and umpires, no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start time in the Premier Section, or between 15 and 30 minutes before the start time in the Senior Section. If a team does not provide a suitable representative for this meeting, the umpires will at their discretion award or delay the toss.

- ii. *Team cards.* Before the toss for innings, the captain of each side must complete a team card nominating their players and give it to the umpires. This must specify the age group of all players aged under 19 on 31 August in the year before the game.
- iii. *Under-12/13 South.* Parental permission must be provided for any player in the under-12 or under-13 age groups.
- iv. *Pre-match meeting.* At the meeting:
 - a. the captains and umpires must agree on drinks intervals and any other issues specific to the game
 - b. both teams will give the umpires a match ball and spares; in the Premier Section the Oxbridge *Windsor* ball must be used; in Divisions 1 & 2 the red Reader *Sovereign* ball must be used; and in Divisions 3 to 9 either the Reader *Sovereign* or *League Special* ball must be used
 - c. the umpires will advise on behaviour standards expected in relation to the Spirit of Cricket, after which captains will be expected to advise their players accordingly

8 Practice on the day of the game

- i. No practice will be allowed on the playing area in the five minutes before the scheduled time of start or the resumption of play after any interval. Other than at these times, practice will be allowed on the playing area on the day of the game whilst play is not in progress, except on the strip being used for the game and the two strips to either side of it. The home team should designate a cut strip on the square and an area on the outfield where the visitors can practice.
- ii. Whilst play is in progress, there will be no practice on the playing area, except that a new bowler will be allowed a maximum of two practice deliveries on the outfield before bowling. The umpires have the authority to stop or not allow practice on the square if weather conditions mean it may cause damage to the surface.

9 Intervals

- i. *Tea.* A tea interval of 30 minutes will normally be taken between innings. When tea is taken during a stoppage due to ground or weather conditions, a further 15-minute interval will be taken between the innings.

- ii. *Drinks*. One drinks interval will normally be taken in each innings; this may be dispensed with or added to only by agreement of both captains at the pre-match meeting.
 - iii. *Rolling the pitch*. The pitch may be rolled for a maximum of seven minutes during the interval between innings. The home side must ensure that a roller is available for this purpose. No other rolling of the pitch will be permitted after the toss.
- 10 **Designated players' viewing areas**. At all games, the home club must provide a designated separate viewing area for players and officials. This may be a balcony or separate area in front of the dressing rooms. In the Premier Section, if this area is not already part of the design of the ground, it should be roped off with appropriate signage.
- 11 **Teas**. The home club will provide teas for both teams, scorers and umpires at all games. All visiting teams must pay for a minimum of 11 teas. The maximum charge for teas is £5 per tea. Teas must be provided for the umpires and scorers free of charge.

12 **Adverse weather conditions**

Before the game

- i. Clubs must take all possible action to ensure that games are played, covering the pitch, repairing used wicket ends, covering run-ups and any vulnerable areas in the days before the game, and using drying equipment where necessary.
- ii. If, having taken all possible action to prepare and protect the pitch and surrounding areas, and taking into account the ground conditions and weather forecast, the home club believes that the prospect of play is remote, they should make verbal contact with the visitors (it is not acceptable to just leave or send a message), no less than three hours (Premier Section) or four hours (Senior Section) before the scheduled start time. At that stage:
 - a. the clubs may agree on whether to cancel the game; *or*
 - b. agreement may be reached to delay a decision for up to three hours; *or*
 - c. where there is no agreement;

- the home side may insist that the fixture is not cancelled and that the visitors must travel; should they do so and there is subsequently no play, the home side will be liable to pay a maximum of £250 to cover the cost of umpires' fees and visitors' travel expenses; *or*
 - the visiting side may insist that the fixture is not cancelled and that they will travel; should they do so and there is subsequently no play, the visitors will be liable to pay a maximum of £250 to cover the cost of umpires' fees and all teas (except where, after subsequent investigation by the league, the pitch, surrounding areas or run-ups were found to have not been adequately covered; in which case, the home side will be liable to pay a maximum of £250 to cover the cost of umpires' fees and visitors' travel expenses);
 - in all cases, when the umpires are on the ground and there is any potential dispute about whether the game should be, or have been, cancelled, the umpire(s) should make a full report on the state of the ground on their WtU match report.
- iii. Where the visiting club believe that the home club have not taken all reasonable steps to get the game on, they should report the circumstances to the relevant Section Head. This report should be accompanied by all available evidence. Prior to reporting, a member of the visiting club should visit the ground to assess the state of the playing area. The home club will be asked to provide evidence of whatever action they had taken to get the game on.
- iv. The relevant Section Head will request the umpires' WtU match report from the Umpires' Appointments Officer and will arrange for representatives of their section committee to consider and rule on the matter. Where they believe that, on the balance of probability, the home club have not made adequate efforts to get the game on, the game may be awarded to the opposition, and/or penalties applied under administrative rule 13.
- v. When a game is in doubt, it is the responsibility of the home club to keep the match umpires apprised of any decisions made under ii above. If a game is cancelled, the home club is responsible for verbally notifying both umpires and the relevant umpires appointments officer without delay – see <https://www.ycspl.co.uk/umpires-section/>

- vi. In the Premier Section, clubs must have:
 - a. adequate covering to protect the pitch, run-ups and any vulnerable areas on the square;
 - b. at least one squeegee, waterhog, or similar machine for removing surface water;
 - c. suitable matting to be used to cover any small unplayable areas on the square during play; *and*
 - d. adequate brushes, towels and sawdust

During the game

- vii. *Rain.* No play will start or restart in rain.
- viii. *Protecting pitches.* Clubs are responsible for taking all possible action to ensure that play can restart promptly after rain. Pitches, including where possible bowlers' run-ups and wicket-ends, should be covered during the game whenever there is a stoppage due to rain.
- ix. *Drying equipment.* Drying equipment, including a soaking machine, forks, and materials to help dry wicket ends, must be available and used on the day of the game whenever necessary.

13 Time lost before and during the game

Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2

- i *Calculating overs lost.* All time lost after the scheduled start time will be aggregated. The first 30 minutes lost will be ignored. The 30 minutes allowed for tea will not count as lost playing time for the purposes of calculating the number of overs to be played, but the additional 15 minutes for the change of innings when tea is taken before the end of the first innings will be counted. Any time lost due to ground, weather or light conditions in excess of 30 minutes (except as in 13.iii) will result in the deduction of four overs for every further complete 15 minutes lost. For example:

<i>Time lost in total</i>	<i>Net loss over 30 mins</i>	<i>Overs deducted</i>
20 mins	Nil	nil
1 hr	30 mins	8
2hrs 25 min	1 hr 55 min	28 (10 min ignored)
4 hrs 10 min	3 hrs 40 min	56 (10 min ignored)

- ii. *Use of DLS.* Where overs are reduced after the start of the game, the result will be determined by the DLS method. DLS version 5 is to be used in all cases.
- iii. *Carrying forward time saved.* Where, for whatever reason, the first innings lasts for less than 3 hours 10 minutes, or a proportionately reduced time, the balance of unused time will be added to the 30 minutes that is allowed before overs are reduced in the second innings. For example, when the first innings lasts for 2 hours 30 minutes and no time has been lost, there is an unused balance of 40 minutes, which means that in the second innings, 1 hour 10 minutes will be allowed before overs are deducted as above.

Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9

iv. *Reducing overs*

- If adverse weather delays the start of a game, umpires will deduct overs on the basis of one over per side for every full seven and a half minutes' play lost. After a game has started there can be no reduction of overs.
- If bad weather is forecast on the day, teams may play a reduced-over game of a minimum 20 overs per side. If captains cannot agree on a reduction, the status quo will apply. The umpires' fees will remain unchanged in a reduced-over game.

v. *Games interrupted by weather after the start.* The cut-off time (para 5.v) includes a 30-minute extension to compensate for the first 30 minutes lost due to stoppages. Play will continue until these cut-off times so long as the umpires consider conditions are fit to do so.

vi. *Safeguarding.* Umpires and captains must be mindful of Safeguarding guidelines when there are ground weather and light issues, or a game continues after normal finishing time

14 Over-rates. Teams are expected to bowl a minimum of 16 overs per hour.

Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2

i. *Target time.* The target time for the completion of a 50-over innings is three hours 10 minutes. This target will be adjusted pro rata in the event of the scheduled number of overs in an innings being less than 50. The umpires may also at their discretion extend the target time allowed for the innings to compensate for unscheduled stoppages.

- ii. *Penalty runs.* Penalty runs will be awarded in the event of an innings not being completed within the target time. The batting side will be awarded five penalty runs for each full over remaining to be bowled at the target time. The over in progress at this time will not count. Penalty runs awarded under this rule will be applied immediately the ball becomes dead after the target time has passed.

Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9

- iii. *Target times.* Teams must bowl their overs within the times shown below:
 - *Divisions 3 to 5* - 2 hours and 55 minutes
 - *Divisions 6 to 9* - 2 hours and 30 minutes
- iv. *Adjusting target times.* These targets will be adjusted pro-rata in the event of the scheduled number of overs in an innings being less than 50. The umpires may also at their discretion extend the target time allowed for the innings to compensate for unscheduled stoppages.
- v. *Penalty runs.* All sides are expected to be in a position to bowl the first ball of the last over within the allocated playing time. In the event of them failing to do so, the full quota of overs will be completed, and the batting side will be credited with five runs for every over that has not been started within the times in 14.iii. This will apply to both innings of the game. If the side batting second is credited with runs in this way, and this consequently takes the score to or past their victory target, then the game will be deemed to have been won by the side batting second.
- vi. All penalties under this rule will be imposed immediately once the ball becomes dead. Play must not continue until the umpires and scorers are satisfied that the score is displayed on the scoreboard. If the innings is terminated before the scheduled or re-scheduled cut-off time, no over-rate penalty shall apply. If the innings is interrupted, the over-rate penalty will apply based on the re-scheduled cessation time for that innings.

15 Fielding restrictions

- i. *Fielding circles.* Throughout the game, the fielding side shall have a minimum of six players, including the wicket keeper and bowler, inside a designated area, which is defined by two semi-circles, each with a radius of 30 yards, with their centres being the middle stumps.

The ends of each semi-circle shall be joined to the other by a straight line drawn on the field on the same side of the pitch. Clubs must use white plastic discs to mark out the designated area; white lines alone are insufficient.

- ii. *No ball penalties.* Either umpire will call and signal a 'no ball' at the instant of delivery if a fielder infringes this rule.
- iii. *Fielder leaving the field of play.* If a fielder leaves the field during play, or is absent at the start of an innings, they will not incur penalty time under Law 24.2 for the first 15 minutes of any absence.
- iv. *Leg-side fielders.* In the Senior Section only, no team shall field no more than five fielders on the leg-side at any time. In the event of any breach, either umpire should call and signal 'no ball'.

16 **Bowling restrictions**

- i. *Short-pitched deliveries.* No bowler may bowl more than two short-pitched deliveries in any over, irrespective of which batsman is on strike. 'Short-pitched' is defined as above shoulder height to the batsman when standing upright in his crease, and will be indicated as such by the bowlers' end umpire. Any subsequent short-pitched delivery will be called a 'no ball.'
- ii. *Full-pitched deliveries.* Any full pitched ball (regardless of pace) which passes or would have passed above waist height of the striker standing upright at the crease shall be called a 'no ball'. The umpire will implement the procedures set out in Law 41.7.1 to Law 41.7.6.
- iii. *Leg-side wides.* In the Premier Section and Divisions 1 and 2, umpires will apply a very strict and consistent interpretation of the law relating to leg-side wide balls. Any ball passing down the leg side of the batsman and outside the line of the leg stump, which does not come into contact with the bat or any part of the batsman's person, will be called and signalled 'wide ball' regardless of any movement on the batsman's part, other than to play a 'reverse sweep' or 'switch hit.' In the latter circumstances, the ball will not be considered a 'wide ball' simply because it has passed the batsman on what would have been his leg-side.
- iv. *Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2.* No bowler shall bowl more than one-third of the overs in an innings (fractions of an over to count as one over), with an upper limit of 15 overs.

- v. *Divisions 3 to 5.* No bowler shall bowl more than one-third of the overs in an innings (fractions of an over to count as one over), with an upper limit of 13 overs.
- vi. *Divisions 6 to 9.* No bowler shall bowl more than one-third of the overs in an innings (fractions of an over to count as one over), with an upper limit of 10 overs.
- vii. *Reductions to bowlers' overs limits.* The maximum number of overs that a bowler may bowl will be reduced pro-rata if the number of overs in the innings is reduced before the start of the innings. The maximum number of overs permitted per bowler will be as follows:

17 **Lost balls.** Lost balls are to be replaced with a ball in similar condition. If the away team, when fielding, lose the match ball and the spare, the home team shall provide all additional balls which shall be approved by the umpires. Members of the batting side must search for any lost balls during play.

18 Scoring

- i. Each team will provide a scorer for the game. All Premier Section teams must have a scorer working towards ACO level 2 standard.

- ii. Should a team fail to provide a scorer, they must nominate a scorer for the whole game from their eleven nominated players. This acting scorer may only be relieved if a suitable alternative scorer is provided. An acting scorer will be allowed to bowl immediately on taking the field.
- iii. The home club must provide an enclosed area for scorers away from spectators. The scoreboard must be updated accurately, at least at the end of each over, and must display the overs remaining, which will include the over being bowled.
- iv. In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, both clubs should check that the scorecard is correctly downloaded after the game, and that any queries, for example, 'unknowns' or registration issues are promptly resolved.
- v. In the Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9:
 - a. A full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the game, (referring to the club's Play-Cricket (P-C) administration Action Centre to clear any outstanding issues) together with the leading performances, must be posted by the home team on their clubs P-C website by 22.30hrs on the day of all games.
 - b. The home team must confirm the full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the game on their club's P-C website by 22.30hrs on the day of the game. The away team must confirm the full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the game by midday on the day following the game, on their club's P-C website, referring to the club's P-C administration Action Centre to clear any outstanding issues.
- vi. Both the home and away clubs must ensure that all players are registered to the YCSPL and identified correctly in all aspects of the administration scorecard within 48 hours following the game start time for games played on the Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday Monday. Any player not identified correctly in all aspects of the scorecard on the administration scorecard will incur a team penalty under League Administrative Rule 13.
- vii. In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, all teams must use the P-C *Scorer Pro* and the Live Scores service.

- 19 Results and point-scoring.** The results of all games will be determined in accordance with Law 21.2.
- i. In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, the DLS system will be used to determine results in the event of inclement weather. A printer must be provided by the home side to enable DLS printouts to be given to captains and umpires. The DLS par score must be displayed on the scoreboard at the end of each over in the second innings.
 - ii. *In the Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9, where the allotted overs cannot be bowled in the second innings, provided that at least 20 overs have been bowled, the result will be determined by comparing the score at the end of the last completed over before play ceased in the second innings with the score after the same number of overs in the first innings. If the scores are equal at that point, the result will be a tie. **
 - iii. *Award of match points.* Points will be awarded in both Sections as follows, irrespective of whether the game has been played over 100 overs, overs are reduced, or whether the DLS method has been used:
 - 12 points for the winning side
 - eight points for both sides in a tied game
 - four points for both sides in any game where a result cannot be achieved
 - bonus points for the losing side based on their second innings performance:
 - a. batting
 - six points for scoring 90% of the total of the side batting first
 - four points for scoring 75%
 - two points for scoring 60%
 - b. bowling
 - six points for taking eight wickets
 - four points for taking six wickets
 - two points for taking four wickets

**.formal proposal to be put to AGM in 2024 to ratify*

- iv *Bonus points in games affected by the weather.* Bonus points will be awarded to the losing side irrespective of whether they are bowled out or whether the allotted overs are bowled:
- In games decided by DLS the batting percentages will be based on the DLS par score at the conclusion of the game; bowling points will be based on the actual number of wickets taken as in 19.v below.
 - where DLS is not used, the batting percentages will be based on the score when the game ends; bowling points will be based on the actual number of wickets taken as in 19.v below.
- v Where the allocated overs are not bowled, bowling bonus points for the losing side will be calculated as follows:

- 20 **Position of teams in the league table.** Where two or more teams have the same number of points in the league table, they will be differentiated by the first of the following criteria that separates them:
- the team with the most wins
 - points won in the games between them
 - net run rate

- 21 **Captains' and umpires' reports.** These will be required only in the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 to 3. After all games in which 25 overs or more have been bowled, captains and umpires must complete relevant online reports. These reports cannot be completed until the following day but must be personally completed by either the team captain or vice-captain and the umpires within three days. In circumstances where no report is required under this rule, ie, when less than 25 overs are played, either captain or umpire may complete a report if there is any issue they wish to draw to attention.
- 22 **Penalties.** Breaches of these rules may result in penalties being imposed in accordance with League Administrative Rule 13.

Match reports

Captains and umpires are reminded that match reports must be completed on *Who's the Umpire* (www.whostheumpire.com) after all games in which 25 overs or more have been bowled in the Premier Section, Divisions 1 to 3, the *K3 Dental Cup*, and the *Whitworth and Mick Savage Cups*. Reports must be personally completed by either the team captain or vice-captain and the umpires within three days after the game (Playing Condition 21).

Live-streaming

It is the responsibility of visiting teams and officials to check the list. Any club or official who does not wish to be streamed must advise the home club at least two days before the game. Home clubs must respect the wishes of visiting teams and officials and not live-stream games when they so request.

Cup & T20 competitions rules 2024

Cup competitions

1. *Governance*. The following arrangements will apply:
 - i. Yorkshire Leagues Knock-Out Cup (currently the *K3 Dental Cup*). The competition will be jointly owned and managed by Yorkshire Premier League North (YPLN) and the YCSPL (specifically the Premier Section cricket committee). Both leagues will nominate two people to form a cup committee that will decide on all matters relating to the interpretation of the rules and to games played in the competition.
 - ii. Whitworth Cup. This competition will be managed by the Premier Section cricket committee.
 - iii. Mick Savage Trophy, President's Trophy and Billy Oates Memorial Cup. These competitions will be managed by the Senior Section cricket committee.
2. *Playing conditions*
 - i. All cup competitions will follow the ECB Generic 40-Over Playing Conditions except as provided for in these rules. There is no carry-over of overs in any cup competition.
 - ii. Leg-side wides and power plays will apply in all cup competitions, except the President's Trophy and the Billy Oates Memorial Cup.
 - iii. Where powerplays are used, the following will apply. At the instant of delivery:
 - **Powerplay 1** – no more than two fielders shall be permitted outside this fielding restriction area. In an innings of 40 overs, these are overs 1 to 8 inclusive.
 - **Powerplay 2** – no more than four fielders shall be permitted outside this fielding restriction area. In an innings of 40 overs, these are overs 9 to 32 inclusive.
 - **Powerplay 3** – no more than five fielders shall be permitted outside this fielding restriction area. In an innings of 40 overs, these are overs 33 to 40 inclusive.

Any adjustments to powerplays due to over reductions will be in accordance with the ECB Generic 40 Over Playing Conditions

- iv. Fielding restrictions in the President's Trophy and the Billy Oates Memorial Cup will be as in league games, ie, six players within the circle at all times.
3. *Club entry to cup competitions*
- i. Eligibility for the different cup competitions is as follows:
 - a. *K3 Dental Cricket Cup* – All 12 Premier Division clubs (entry is mandatory).
 - b. *Whitworth Cup* – All 12 Championship Division clubs, the two clubs relegated from the Championship at the end of the previous season, plus the third- and fourth-placed clubs in Division 1 at the end of the previous season (entry is mandatory).
 - c. *Mick Savage Trophy*. The eight remaining Division 1 teams plus all 12 Division 2 teams (entry is mandatory).
 - d. *President's Trophy*. Will be open to all teams in Divisions 3 to 5, subject to a maximum of one team per club (entry is optional).
 - e. *Billy Oates Memorial Cup*. Will be open to all teams in Divisions 6 to 9, subject to a maximum of one team per club (entry is optional).
 - ii. Where it is necessary to vary the competition into which clubs in Division 1 and below are entered, this will be at the discretion of the Senior Section cricket committee.
4. *Fixtures*
- i. Games will normally be played on Sundays or Bank Holidays. Except in the final, games will start at 12.30 hrs (*K3 Dental Cup*) and 12 noon (all others). All finals will start at 12 noon. Games before the final may start later to accommodate a junior or womens' & girls' game, if so agreed by both teams involved. Scheduled dates for each round will be provided by the competitions manager prior to the start of the competition.
 - ii. Where there is a clash with ECB National Club Championship, the latter will take precedence; in the event of a clash with any other cup competition, including the National Village knock-out cup, the YCSPL cup game must take precedence. Otherwise, these dates may only be changed in exceptional circumstances, where agreed by both clubs and the head of the relevant YCSPL Section.

5. *Late arrival of players.* The provisions of Laws 24 and 25 will apply in the *K3 Dental Cup*, the *Whitworth Cup* and the *Mick Savage Trophy*. In the *President's Trophy* and the *Billy Oates Memorial Cup*, any player arriving late may take a full part in the match. Immediately on the arrival of the late player, the captain must inform the umpire of their arrival.
6. *Results*
- i. In all games in the *K3 Dental Cup*, *Whitworth Cup* and *Mick Savage Trophy*, and the finals of all other cup competitions, where weather and ground conditions result in a loss of overs, DLS will be used to achieve a result.
 - ii. When DLS is not used and weather and ground conditions result in a loss of overs, provided that a minimum of ten overs have been bowled in the second innings, the result will be determined by comparing the score at the end of the last completed over of the second innings, with the score at the end of the corresponding over in the first innings. The winner will be the side that has scored the most runs, or, if runs are equal, the side that has lost the fewest wickets. It is necessary therefore, where DLS is not being used, for scorers to note the score at the end of each over. If a result cannot be achieved in this manner, 6.iii below will apply.
 - iii. Except in the *K3 Dental Cup*, where a result is not achieved on the field in a game up to and including the quarter-final stage, the game will be decided by a 'bowl out' or 'coin toss'.
 - iv. In order to constitute a game, both sides must have the opportunity to bat for a minimum of ten overs.
 - v. In the event of a reserve date being required, the organising committee may, in exceptional circumstances, allow that date to be adjusted as long as the game is completed at least seven days before the scheduled date for the next round. Any rearrangement must be authorised by the relevant YCSPL Section committee by email.
7. *Cancellations.* When a game is cancelled before the scheduled start time, it will be the responsibility of the home team to contact the visitors and umpires to let them know that the game will not take place. They should make verbal contact with the both (it is not acceptable to just leave or send a message).

8. *Balls.* In the *K3 Dental Cup* and *Whitworth Cup*, one new pink *Dukes County International* ball will be used in each innings. The ball used for the *Mick Savage Trophy* will be the red *Readers Sovereign*; and for *President's Trophy* and *Billy Oates Memorial Cup* will be the red *Readers Sovereign* or *League Special*.
9. *Clothing and equipment*
 - i. Coloured clothing must be worn in the *K3 Dental Cup* and *Whitworth Cup*, but equipment such as pads and batting gloves are not required to be colour co-ordinated.
 - ii. White clothing must be worn in the *Mick Savage Trophy*, *President's Trophy* and *Billy Oates Memorial Cup*.
 - iii. The provisions of *League Administrative Rule 43* must also be followed in all cases.
 - iv. Sightscreens may be black or white.

T20 competitions

10. *YCSPL T20 competitions.* Two T20 competitions will be run, the *T20 Blast* and *T20 plate*. The winners of the *T20 Blast* will progress into the national *Vitality T20* competition; the winners of the *T20 Plate* will progress into the national *Vitality T20 plate* competition.
11. *Governance.* The *T20 Blast* competition will be the responsibility of the *Premier Section Cricket Committee* and the *T20 Plate* competition will be the responsibility of the *Senior Section Cricket Committee*.
12. *Playing conditions.* Both competitions will follow the rules of the [ECB Generic 20-over playing conditions](#).
13. *Club entry*
 - i. Entry to the *T20 Blast* competition is mandatory for all *Premier Division* clubs.
 - ii. A maximum of 12 clubs not in the *Premier Division* may enter their first XI team in the *T20 Plate* competition. If more than 12 clubs wish to enter, the top 12 will be admitted, based on the previous season's league tables.

14. *Format.* The two competitions will each comprise a group stage, a semi-finals day, and a finals day, as follows:
- i. *In the group stage,* there will be four groups, each comprising of three teams. Each team will play the other two in their group, and points will be awarded on the basis of two for a win; one for a tie or 'no result'; and none for a defeat. Games will be scheduled to start at 10.00, 13.15 and 16.30.
 - ii. If two teams finish level at the top of their group, the team that won the game between the two will be the group winner. If this game is a tie or 'no result', the group winner will be decided on net run rate. Net run rate is calculated as (runs scored/overs faced) minus (runs conceded/overs bowled). Where net run rate is used, if a side is bowled out inside its' scheduled overs, the calculation should use the overs allocated rather than the actual overs bowled. The calculation excludes 'no result' games.
 - iii. *In the semi-finals,* the four group winners will play each other on the ground of the club drawn first. Clubs in the semi-final stage may bring games forward by mutual agreement, and they may be played in an evening, provided that they are played by the scheduled date. Any rearrangement must be notified to the head of the relevant YCSPL Section.
 - iv. *Finals.* The *finals* of both competitions will be played on the same day on the same ground, with the Plate final commencing at 11.00 and the Blast final at 15.00. Wherever possible, there will be a one-hour break between the two games to enable proper preparation prior to the Blast final.
15. *Cancellations.* When play is cancelled before the scheduled start time, it will be the responsibility of the host team to contact the visitors and umpires to let them know that games will not take place. They should make verbal contact with the both (it is not acceptable to just leave or send a message).
16. *Balls.* In the T20 Blast competition, a new pink Oxbridge *Magna* ball will be used for each innings; in the T20 Plate competition, a new Reader pink ball will be used for each innings.

17. *Clothing and equipment*

- i. Coloured clothing must be worn, but equipment such as pads and batting gloves are not required to be colour-co-ordinated. The provisions of League Administrative Rule 43 must also be observed.
- ii. Sightscreens may be black or white.

18. *Deciding results of games*

- i. In all games in the T20 Blast and the finals of the T20 Plate, where weather and ground conditions result in a loss of overs, DLS will be used to achieve a result.
- ii. In games in the T20 Plate, other than finals day, DLS may be used to achieve a result when weather and ground conditions result in a loss of overs.
- iii. Where DLS cannot be used, the result will be determined by comparing the score at the end of the last completed over of the second innings, with the score at the end of the corresponding over in the first innings. A minimum of five overs have been bowled in the second innings. The winner will be the side that has scored the most runs, or, if runs are equal, the side that has lost the fewest wickets. It is necessary therefore, where DLS is not being used, for scorers to note the score at the end of each over.
- iv. If a result cannot be achieved by the above means, the game will be decided by a 'bowl out' or 'coin toss'.

General

19. *Playing conditions.* All games in these competitions will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game, the Spirit of Cricket and all current ECB directives, except where specifically stated in these rules. Free hits will apply in all cup and T20 competitions. Pitches must be marked with the 17" lines to assist umpires judge wide balls in the K3 Dental Cup, Whitworth Cup, the Mick Savage Trophy and both T20 competitions.

20. *Player eligibility*

- i. Players will only be eligible to play in the cup competitions if, as bona fide registered members of their club, they are eligible to play in the YCSPL.
- ii. A player may only play for one club in any cup competition in a given season.

- iii. Overseas players and contracted county staff are eligible to play in the competition, provided that they comply with the above.
 - iv. The provisions of administrative rule 47 must be followed in relation to team selection for all cup games.
21. *Scoring.* Clubs must provide a scorer for all games. Where no scorer is provided, a player must be designated to undertake scoring duties and the side must play with a player short. Matches shall be scored where possible utilising electronic methods with live scoring, to promote the competition. Where electronic scoring is not possible, clubs should give regular score updates via social media.
22. *Umpires.* Umpires will be appointed for all games by the Appointments Officer via 'Who's The Umpire'. Where umpires attend the ground, whether the game commences or not, they will be entitled to their full fees.
23. *Match Results*
- i. In all games where Live Scoring is used, both clubs should check that the scorecard is correctly downloaded after the game, and that any queries, for example, 'unknowns' or registration issues are promptly resolved.
 - ii. In games where Live Scoring is not used:
 - a. A full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the match, (referring to your club's Play-Cricket administration Action Centre to clear any outstanding issues) together with the leading performances, must be posted by the home team on their club's Play-Cricket website by 22.30hrs on the day of the match for all matches.
 - b. The home team must confirm the full summary result and full detailed scorecard, after the clearance in their Action Centre on their club's Play-Cricket website of all outstanding issues relating to the match, by 22.30hrs on the day of the match. The away team must confirm the full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the match by midday on the day following the match, on their club's Play-Cricket website, referring to the club's Play-Cricket administration Action Centre to clear any outstanding issues.

- c. Both the home and away clubs must ensure that all players are registered to the YCSPL and identified correctly in all aspects of the administration scorecard within 48 hours following the match start time for matches played on the Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday Monday. Any player not identified correctly in all aspects of the scorecard on the administration scorecard will incur a team penalty as in rule 13.
- iii Cup Games. Games cannot be entered as abandoned or cancelled, as a result must be obtained at some time. Summary results, scorecards or other details must not be entered if the game was abandoned, cancelled, or requires a replay. The competition administrator must instead be advised of the date of the re-scheduled game.
24. *Concessions and failure to field a team.* A club entered in any League cup or T20 competition that concedes or fails to field a team with less than eight days' notice, will be liable to disqualification from future cup and T20 competitions and a penalty under Admin Rule 13.
25. *Time lost before and during the game*

K3 Dental, Whitworth & Mick Savage cups; all cup finals; T20 games

- i *Calculating overs lost.* All time lost after the scheduled start time will be aggregated. The first 30 minutes lost will be ignored. The 30 minutes allowed for tea will not count as lost playing time for the purposes of calculating the number of overs to be played, but the additional 15 minutes for the change of innings when tea is taken before the end of the first innings will be counted. Any time lost due to ground, weather or light conditions in excess of 30 minutes (except as in Playing Condition 13.iii) will result in the deduction of four overs for every further complete 15 minutes lost. For example:

- ii *Use of DLS.* Where overs are reduced after the start of the game, the result will be determined by the DLS method. DLS version 5 is to be used in all cases.

Reducing overs

- If adverse weather delays the start of a game, umpires will deduct overs on the basis of one over per side for every full seven and a half minutes' play lost. After a game has started there can be no reduction of overs.
- If bad weather is forecast on the day, teams may play a reduced-over game of a minimum 20 overs per side. If captains cannot agree on a reduction, the status quo will apply.

- 26 *Reports.* Umpires and captains' reports will only be required in the K3 Dental Cup, Whitworth Cup and Mick Savage Trophy.
- 27 *Finals.* Costs of the finals for the cup and T20 competitions, including balls, teas and umpires, will be met by the League.
- 28 *Conduct of games.* In all respects not specifically provided for in these rules, games will be played in accordance with the relevant YCSPL rules and policies.
- 29 *Disputes.* All issues in connection with the running of these competitions will be decided by the relevant organising committee. In the event of any appeal against any decision of the committee, the grounds for appeal must be notified by email to the head of the relevant YCSPL Section within seven days of the notification of the decision in question. Arrangements will be made for an appeal to be heard by panel made up of three people with no connection with any club involved.

HALL OF FAME



The *Hall of Fame* was introduced by the Yorkshire South Premier League to recognise individuals who 'have given outstanding service to our clubs or our league'. It has been carried forward in the YCSPL, with inductions from across the whole league. Its members are:

1. **Bill Croft.** Former Sheffield Collegiate CC seam bowler and tireless committee worker, who became President of the Yorkshire League and is still closely associated with the Collegiate club.
2. **Steve Foster.** One of the finest cricketers produced in Yorkshire not to play in the first-class game. An outstanding all-rounder for Treeton CC, for whom he continues to play and is now vice-chairman.
3. **Andy Harrison.** Yorkshire League opening bowler with Rotherham before moving to Wickersley Old Village, whom he captained to seven South Yorkshire titles. He has served Wickerley in numerous roles and is a YCSPL committee member.
4. **Bob Leafe.** Cleethorpes CC's record run-scorer, who served the club for over fifty years as player, captain, committee member and, most recently, cricket chairman. He is still actively involved at Chichester Road.
5. **Stuart Roberts.** After a playing career spent mainly at Conisborough CC, he became one of Yorkshire's best umpires in an outstanding umpiring career that included over thirty years on the Premier League panel.
6. **Dennis Wadd.** Appleby Frodingham CC's first team scorer for 54 years; he was a familiar friendly face, a meticulous scorer and an ever-popular figure on grounds across Lincolnshire and Yorkshire until passing away in 2022.
7. **Nick Cowan.** A Yorkshire League legend who led first Rotherham Town and then Doncaster Town to League titles; before leading the latter to the 1998 National Club Championship. Closely involved with DTCC until passing away last December.
8. **Keith Haynes.** 'Mr Treeton', whose own playing career with the club was eclipsed by a 31-year tenure as club chairman, during which time he has been the driving force behind making the club what it is today and is still the club groundsman.
9. **Richard Wilkinson.** One of South Yorkshire's most popular and talented all-rounders. A stalwart of Barnsley, Whitley Hall and the Yorkshire Academy, his vast experience now benefits the YCB. Now starring with his home club Wombwell Main.
10. **Matt Dixon.** Served for 12 years as captain of Sheffield Collegiate CC; a former Yorkshire League committee member who was closely involved in the creation of the YSPL, of which he was vice-chairman for three years.
11. **Harry Fielder.** An ever popular and respected 'old school' umpire who served 16 years on the Yorkshire Premier Leagues panel and is now on the League panel. Harry rarely, if ever, refuses any appointment.
12. **Kevin Motley.** A dedicated and meticulous scorer for many seasons, recognised as one of the best in the country, and founder of this Almanac, who passed away last year.
13. **Terry Bentham.** The legendary League Ambassador has been a huge figure in South Yorkshire cricket for over 40 years, through his dedicated contribution to league administration and umpiring.
14. **Steve Fletcher.** Steve was known as 'Mr Whitley Hall' through his enormous contribution to the club in every possible role over 53 years before he passed away in 2022.
15. **Iain Mallett.** A dedicated servant of Millhouses Works CC for the last 30 years in numerous roles, his biggest achievements are putting in place the club's junior structure and masterminding the completion of the club's magnificent new pavilion.
16. **Steve Reid.** Steve Reid, who passed away in 2021, was a loyal servant of Penistone CC for 47 years, during which time he was probably best known for his coaching work with juniors and his long and indefatigable service as club groundsman.
17. **Milton Samuels.** The hugely-respected first chair of the League's Equity & Diversity Group, who has run Caribbean Sports CC since he was instrumental in founding it in 1967.
18. **Richard Storer.** Club secretary at Hallam CC for 35 years and now chairman, Richard has been the driving force behind the growth of the club into one of the country's leading producers of junior players.
19. **Mark Beardshall.** Former opening bowler with Derbyshire, who played with distinction in the Bradford, Huddersfield and Yorkshire Leagues; a long-serving vice-chairman of Barnsley Woolley Miners CC and is a YCSPL committee member.
20. **Mick Bocking.** 'Mr Bradfield' has served his club with distinction for over 30 years as player, administrator and groundsman and is a key member of the League's disciplinary team.
21. **Peter Holes.** Peter has served Norton Oakes CC for 47 years, initially as an upper-order batsman, but since then in practically every role at the club, in particular in setting up its thriving junior section.
22. **Ian Swallow.** Ian's distinguished 50-year playing career started at Elsecar CC, and included Yorkshire CCC, Somerset CCC, and Meltham CC in the Huddersfield League, before leading his 'home club' to the *Black Sheep* Yorkshire Championship.
23. **Mark Wilson.** A metronomic medium-fast bowler for Wath CC for over 40 years, who has gone on to represent Yorkshire and England over 50s.
24. **Ann Burdett.** Ann Burdett is the very epitome of the selfless volunteers that form the fabric of so many of our cricket clubs. Always a welcoming face at Shiregreen CC, where she has now provided the teas for players and officials for over sixty years.
25. **David Clayton.** David represented the Frecheville Community club as an attacking middle order batsman over six decades, and has now served the club loyally a chairman and groundsman for over 15 years.
26. **Brian Fletcher.** A stalwart committee member of the South Yorkshire Senior Cricket League for 37 years, the last seven as President, and who was made a life member of the YCSPL on its formation in 2021.
27. **Martin Ivill.** Martin enjoyed a highly-successful league playing career as an opening bowler. After his senior debut aged 12 at Wombwell Main, he played with great distinction for Barnsley and Sheffield Collegiate; still playing for Yorkshire o/60s at 72.
28. **Brian Sissons.** Brian spent nearly all of his playing days with Rotherham Phoenix as an all-rounder, noted for his brilliant captaincy. He then served Phoenix and Tickhill tirelessly off the field, playing a big part in Tickhill's rise to prominence.
