# League competition rules 2025

---

## General

- 1 **Scope.** These rules govern all YCSPL league and cup competitions.
- 2 **Changes to these rules.** Either the relevant cricket committee or clubs may propose changes to these rules. Significant material changes will need to be voted upon at the AGM by clubs in membership of the appropriate section for the following season. Clubs must notify any proposals for changes to the head of the relevant section no later than 31 August, in order to ensure that they can be properly considered and notice given to clubs.
- 3 **Complaints and disputes.** Any dispute or complaint that may arise, between clubs or between clubs and league officials, must, in the first instance, be referred to the Head of the relevant section by email within 14 days of the incident arising. All disputes will be dealt with in accordance with Administrative Rule 73.
- 4 **Grounds and facilities.** Clubs must comply with YCSPL Ground & Facilities requirements as follows:
  - i. Premier Section clubs are required to adhere to the requirements of the *Premier Section Ground & Facility Standards* – see website.
  - ii. Senior Section clubs must comply with the relevant *Ground & facilities criteria* – see website.
  - iii. In Senior Section Divisions 7 to 9, ECB-approved artificial pitches may be used, with advance permission of the Senior Section committee, provided that there are adequate dressing rooms, scoring facilities, and sightscreens.
  - iv. In the Premier Section, the home club must provide a designated separate viewing area for players and officials. This may be a balcony or separate area in front of the dressing rooms. If this area is not already part of the design of the ground, it should be roped off with appropriate signage.

### Structure of League rules

- Matters concerning the conduct of the game itself are contained in '[League playing conditions](#)', '[Cup playing conditions](#)' and '[T20 Playing conditions](#)'
- Matters concerning the competition in which the game is being played are contained in 'Competition Rules'
- All other matters, including administration, player eligibility and disputes, are contained in 'Administrative Rules'

- 5 **Live-Streaming.** All clubs must comply with the League *Filming and Live-Streaming Policy* – see page 23.
- 6 **Spectators.** Both clubs are responsible for the behaviour of spectators on match-days. In the event of unacceptable behaviour by the followers of a particular club, that club will be expected to investigate and take action as necessary. Any reports to the League of unacceptable behaviour by spectators will be dealt with as a disciplinary matter.
- 7 **Arrangement of fixtures.** All fixtures will be arranged by the competitions manager. Changes to the fixture list will be permitted only in accordance with Administrative Rule 41.
- 8 **Getting the game on**
- i. Clubs must take all possible action to ensure that games are played, covering the pitch, repairing used wicket ends, covering run-ups and any vulnerable areas in the days before the game, and using drying equipment where necessary.
  - ii. If, having taken all possible action to prepare and protect the pitch and surrounding areas, and taking into account the ground conditions and weather forecast, the home club believes that the prospect of play is remote, they should make verbal contact with the visitors and umpires (it is not acceptable to just leave or send a message), no less than three hours before the scheduled start time. At that stage:
    - a. the clubs may agree on whether to cancel the game; *or*
    - b. agree to delay a decision for up to three hours; *or*
    - c. where there is no agreement;
      - the home side may insist that the fixture is not cancelled and that the visitors must travel; should they do so and there is subsequently no play, the home side will be liable to pay a maximum of £250 to cover the cost of umpires' fees and visitors' travel expenses; *or*
      - the visiting side may insist that the fixture is not cancelled and that they will travel; should they do so and there is subsequently no play, the visitors will be liable to pay a maximum of £250 to cover the cost of umpires' fees and all teas (except where, after subsequent investigation by the league, the pitch, surrounding areas or run-ups were found to have not been adequately covered; in which case, the home side will be liable to pay a maximum of £250 to cover the cost of umpires' fees and visitors' travel expenses);

- in all cases, when the umpires are on the ground and there is any potential dispute about whether the game should be, or have been, cancelled, the umpire(s) should make a full report on the state of the ground on their WhosTheUmpire (WTU) match report.
- iii. Where the visiting club believe that the home club have not taken all reasonable steps to get the game on, they should report the circumstances to the relevant Section Head. This report should be accompanied by all available evidence. Prior to reporting, a member of the visiting club should visit the ground to assess the state of the playing area. The home club will be asked to provide evidence of whatever action they had taken to get the game on.
  - iv. The relevant Section Head will request the umpires' WTU match report from the Umpires' Appointments Officer and will arrange for representatives of their section committee to consider and rule on the matter. Where they believe that, on the balance of probability, the home club have not made adequate efforts to get the game on, the game may be awarded to the opposition, and/or penalties applied under administrative rule 29.
  - v. When a game is in doubt, it is the responsibility of the home club to keep the match umpires apprised of any decisions made under ii above. If a game is cancelled, the home club is responsible for verbally notifying both umpires and the relevant umpires appointments officer without delay.
  - vi. In the Premier Section, clubs must have:
    - a. adequate covering to protect the pitch, run-ups and any vulnerable areas on the square;
    - b. at least one squeegee, waterhog, or similar machine for removing surface water;
    - c. suitable matting to be used to cover any small unplayable areas on the square during play; *and*
    - d. adequate brushes, towels and sawdust
- 9 **Cancellations.** When a game is cancelled before the scheduled start time, it will be the responsibility of the home team to contact the visitors, umpires and umpires' appointments officer to let them know that the game will not take place. They should make verbal contact with them – it is not acceptable to just leave or send a message.

## 10 Teams

- i. Clubs playing less than 11 players in games in the Premier Section, Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, Whitworth Cup, Mick Savage Trophy and T20 competitions will be liable to penalties under Administrative Rule 29.
- ii. In the event that a club cannot field 11 players in all of its fixtures on a particular day, then a lower team must not field more than or equal to the number of players in the higher team.

11 **Player eligibility.** All players must be registered on Play-Cricket in accordance with Administrative Rules 44-49.

12 **Overseas players.** In addition to 11 above, all overseas players in the YCSPL must be approved for registration by the Compliance Manager and registered by 30 June in accordance with Administrative Rules 47 and 53-56.

13 **Player transfers.** Transfers of players must be conducted in accordance with the transfer procedure set out in Administrative Rules 57-59.

## 14 Loan players

- i. Loans are permitted in accordance with the loan procedure set out in Administrative Rules 60-62. They are intended only to assist shorthanded clubs, and must be sanctioned by the YCSPL Play-Cricket administrator in advance. Loan players will only be allowed to play in the lowest team in any club.
- ii. No loan players will be allowed in the Premier Section, above Division 3 in the Senior Section, or in cup games, with the exception that junior players signed under Administrative Rule 61.iv will be allowed to play in the President's Cup and Billy Oates Memorial Cup.
- iii. Other than juniors, no loan players will be allowed after the last Saturday in August.
- iv. Junior players under 16 may be loaned out either;
  - a. for a complete season, subject to the written consent of the lending club, *or*
  - b. on a week-to-week basis only
- v. Any club using this system to strengthen their team will be deemed to have breached rule 16 below.

- 15 **Dual registration of students.** Category 1 registration students whose home and their higher education establishment are in different parts of the UK may be allowed to dual register with two clubs, subject to the agreement of both clubs, and verification of their student status, in accordance with administrative rule 50.
- 16 **Player selection.** All clubs are expected to play their strongest possible team that is eligible to play in that division in all games, in line with the Spirit of Cricket. It is not acceptable for clubs to select players from a higher division team to play in a lower division team and thus strengthen that team. This does not prevent players recovering from injury or loss of form from being selected for a lower division team. Breaches of this rule will be dealt with as in Administrative Rule 29. In addition:
- i. Where a club believe that an opposing side has breached this rule, they should report the matter to the relevant Section Head within seven days of the date of the game in question, giving all relevant details of the complaint. Complaints must be accompanied by a £50 deposit, which will be refunded if the complaint has merit; otherwise it will be donated to junior cricket. Complaints under this rule may be accepted up to ten days after the game where there is demonstrably good reason for the delay.
  - ii. Irrespective of whether a complaint is made, the relevant Section committee may investigate any instance where they believe a breach of this rule may have taken place. The club concerned must be notified of the intent to investigate within ten days of the game taking place.
  - iii. Where a breach of this rule is deemed to have taken place:
    - a. the result of the game will be declared a win for the non-offending team;
    - b. in league games, maximum points will be awarded to the non-offending side; no points will be awarded to the offending side, upon whom a penalty of maximum win points will also be imposed;
    - c. in cup matches, the non-offending side will go through to the next round; the offending team will be deemed to have lost the match, and may be suspended from that competition in the following season.
  - iv. In deciding whether the rule has been breached, the following factors will be taken into account.
    - a. At the time of the game, a player must have made at least 50% of their Saturday league appearances for the lower team, unless:

- they have been dropped due to loss of form – note that; in the case of Sunday or Bank Holiday games, they must not have played in the higher team on the previous day, and in determining eligibility for the lower team under this criteria, previous performances in the higher team will be considered;
  - they are returning to playing action after an absence of more than two weeks, due to injury, holiday, ban or other genuine unavailability.
- b. Rearranged league games that have taken place on a Saturday will count for the purposes of (a) above, only where their original date was before the game in which the alleged breach occurred.
  - c. If a game is replayed or rearranged for any reason, only those players registered and eligible on the original date can play; in the case of a player who had a suspension covering the date of the original game, they will be eligible to play if their full suspension term is served before the new date.
  - d. This rule will not apply to players in age groups under 15 and below.
  - e. Any player who is not eligible to play for a lower team according to the above criteria may only do so with the advance permission of the Senior Section head. This permission will be granted only where there is considered to be good reason, not covered by the above, and where permission is requested by email at least 72 hours before the game takes place.

## 17 Players' attire

- i. *White clothing.* 'Whites' must be worn on the field for all league games and cup games where specified. Shirts, jumpers, trousers and shoes must be either white or cream. The only areas where colour will be permitted are:
  - shirts – collar, cuffs, under-arm panels
  - jumpers – in a lined pattern around the border to the V-neck, the cuff, or around the bottom of the garment; as traditionally worn for cricket games
  - trousers - no coloured stripes or patterns are allowed on trousers
  - shoes – shoes may have coloured trim but must be predominantly white or cream
  - headgear – caps or hats may be coloured, but beanies or bobble hats are not permitted.



- ii. *Coloured clothing.* Coloured clothing should be worn for cup competitions where so specified, and for all T20 games. The restrictions detailed above for white clothing do not apply, but the provisions of *iii* to *vii* below must be followed.
  - iii. *Club logos and names.* These may be displayed on shirts, jumpers and/or trousers.
  - iv. *Sponsors.* Logos and names of club sponsors may be worn on players' shirts and/or sweaters. They can be either on the collar, sleeve, chest, chest pockets or across the back. The name of one sponsor may be displayed in lettering across the chest.
  - v. *Charity endorsements.* Clubs may decide to support a bona fide registered charity by putting the name and logo of that charity on all their club shirts.
  - vi. *Names and numbers.* The name and number of the players may be displayed on the back of shirt and jumpers; a number and/or initials may be displayed on trousers.
  - vii. *Slogans.* No slogans of any nature may be displayed on clothing worn by players playing in a game or at any time during the course of the game.
  - viii. *General.* Clubs are reminded that the appearance of players reflects on the club and the League. Clothing worn by players at all times during the course of a game should be smart and conform to the above. If any doubt exists as to whether proposed clothing meets these rules, a formal approach must be made to the Head of the relevant cricket section. The decision of the League Executive Board on permissible attire will be final and binding.
- 18 **Match balls.** Each side will be responsible for the provision of the match ball and at least one suitable spare of the make and type specified in the playing conditions. In the Whitworth Cup and T20 competitions, the League will purchase and distribute balls before games, and invoice clubs on the basis of the number of balls they play in these competitions. The League will provide balls for the finals' day in all cup and T20 competitions.

## 19 Umpires

- i. Umpires will be appointed to games by the Premier Leagues Umpires Association or the South Yorkshire Association Appointments' Officer; except where a club's own umpires are used in the Senior Section Divisions 3-9 only.

- ii. Where no umpires are appointed by the League, it shall be the responsibility of the batting side to provide umpires for that innings, and the club captains will be jointly responsible for ensuring that the game is conducted within the Spirit of Cricket and that League safeguarding policies are followed.
  - iii. Should only one umpire be appointed by the League, it will be the responsibility of the batting team to provide the striker's end umpire.
  - iv. All persons standing as umpires must be suitably dressed in an umpire's coat, not in casual dress or shorts. Clubs must have two clean umpires' jackets available for all matches. No player under the age of 19 who is not a qualified umpire must be asked to stand as an umpire.
  - v. Umpires' expenses will include travelling costs, will be reviewed annually and will be published in the matchday handbook and on the website. They must be paid prior to the resumption of play after tea. Each team will be responsible for paying one umpire. Once the umpires have arrived at the ground the full expenses will be payable, irrespective of whether or not play takes place. Where only one appointed umpire stands in a game, one and a half times the normal expenses will be payable.
- 20 **Scorers – use of juniors.** Clubs must ensure that they meet their safeguarding responsibilities in terms of junior scorers, paying particular attention to the following:
- i. there is no lower age limit for scorers, but clubs must be completely satisfied about the ability and concentration span of junior scorers, particularly if under 13,
  - ii. where there is a junior scorer at a game, it is recommended that scoring should take place outside, but, where this is not practicable, the door to the scorebox must remain open, and a welfare check should be made at least twice in each innings, *and*
  - iii. it is strongly recommended that juniors score on a laptop or tablet rather than a mobile phone.

## 21 **Scoring**

- i. All Premier Section teams must have a scorer of, or working towards, ACO level 2 standard. Senior Section scorers should be on the ACO scorers' pathway and or working towards, ACO level 1 standard.
- ii. Provided that scorers meet the criteria in i above, the League strongly recommends that payments to scorers are a minimum of two-thirds of the expenses payable to umpires for the game in question.

- iii. The home club must provide an enclosed area for scorers away from spectators. The scoreboard must be updated accurately, at least at the end of each over, and must display the overs remaining, which will include the over being bowled.
  - iv. In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, the Whitworth Cup and T20 competitions, matches shall be scored using Play-Cricket (P-C) Scorer Pro and Live Scores. In all other competitions, matches shall be scored where possible utilising electronic methods with live scoring, to promote the competition.
  - v. Both clubs should check that the scorecard is correctly uploaded after the game, and that any queries in their P-C Action Centre are promptly resolved as in Administrative Rule 37.ii.
  - vi. A full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the game, (referring to the club's P-C Action Centre to clear any outstanding issues) together with the leading performances, must be posted by the home team on their clubs P-C website by 22.30 hrs on the day of all games.
  - vii. The away team must confirm the full summary result and full detailed scorecard of the game by midday on the day following the game, on their club's P-C website, referring to the club's P-C administration Action Centre to clear any outstanding issues.
  - viii. Both the home and away clubs must ensure that all players are registered to the YCSPL and identified correctly in all aspects of the administration scorecard within 48 hours following the game start time for games played on the Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday Monday. Any player not identified correctly in all aspects of the scorecard on the administration scorecard will be liable incur a team penalty under Administrative Rule 29.
- 22 **Teas.** In all cup and league games teas must be provided at the interval for teams, umpires and scorers. In T20 games, teas will be provided at the end of the game. Visiting clubs will be required to pay for a minimum of 11 teas and the maximum charge per tea will be £5. In all cases, teas must be provided for match officials free of charge.

## 23 Captains' reports

- i. Captains must complete online reports on [www.whostheumpire.com](http://www.whostheumpire.com) after all games in the Premier Section, Divisions 1 to 3, the Whitworth Cup and Mick Savage Trophy in which 25 overs or more have been bowled.

- ii. Reports must be personally completed by either the team captain or vice-captain on the day after the game or the two days thereafter. Failure to complete reports within this timescale may result in penalties being applied as in Administrative Rule 29.
- iii. Where no report is required under this rule, either captain may complete a report if there is any issue they wish to draw to attention.

#### 24 Umpires' reports

- i. Umpires must complete online reports on [www.whostheumpire.com](http://www.whostheumpire.com) after all games in the Premier Section, Divisions 1 to 3, the Whitworth Cup and Mick Savage Trophy in which 25 overs or more have been bowled.
- ii. Reports must be completed by either umpire on the day after the game or the two days thereafter.
- iii. Where no report is required under this rule, umpires may complete a report if there is any issue they wish to draw to attention.

### League games

#### 25 Rearrangement of fixtures

- i. When a game is re-arranged for any reason, if there is no result in 75% or more games in that division on the original date, then the re-arranged match will also be regarded as an abandoned game.
- ii. Where a full rearranged programme is agreed for the Premier Section, Senior Section teams may be allowed the option of rearrangement, at the discretion of the Senior Section committee.

#### 26 County players. Any county player who has played first class or list A cricket for any county or a Hundred franchise in that season, may play for a club in the YCSPL in a league game provided that they:

- i. were registered for that club at the start of the season,
- ii. have not in the same season played Saturday league cricket for any other club, *and*
- iii. make their first such appearance in the YCSPL by 31 July.

#### 27 Award of match points. Points will be awarded in both Sections as follows, irrespective of whether the game has been played over 100 overs, overs are reduced, or whether the DLS method has been used:

- i. 12 points for the winning side
- ii. Eight points for both sides in a tied game

- iii. Four points for both sides in any game where a result cannot be achieved
- iv. Bonus points for the losing side based on their second innings performance as follows:
- batting
    - six points for scoring 90% of the total of the side batting first
    - four points for scoring 75%
    - two points for scoring 60%
  - bowling
    - six points for taking nine wickets
    - four points for taking seven wickets
    - two points for taking five wickets
- v. Bonus points in games affected by the weather will be awarded to the losing side irrespective of whether they are bowled out or whether the allotted overs are bowled.
- In games where DLS has been used to obtain a result, the batting percentages will be based on the DLS par score at the conclusion of the game; bowling points will be based on the actual number of wickets taken as in 27.vi below.
  - where DLS is not used, the batting percentages will be based on the countback score (League Playing Condition 13.ii), and bowling points will be based on the actual number of wickets taken
- vi. Where the allocated overs are not bowled, bowling bonus points for the losing side will be calculated as follows:

**28 Position of teams in the league table.** Where two or more teams have the same number of points in the league table, they will be differentiated by the first of the following criteria that separates them:

- the team with the most wins
- points won in the games between them
- net run rate

## 29 Promotion and relegation

- i. Promotion and relegation between divisions will normally take place in accordance with the following:

<i>Division</i>	<i>Promotion</i>	<i>Relegation</i>
Premier	None	2 teams to Championship
Championship	2 teams to Premier	2 teams to Division 1
Division 1	2 teams to Championship	2 teams to Division 2
Division 2	2 teams to Division 1	2/3 teams to Division 3
Divisions 3-9	2/3 teams to the division above	2/3 teams to the division below (except from Division 9)

- ii. Where, for any reason, a team in a promotion position will not take their place in the higher division, they will only be replaced by the next-placed team where that team is within no more than 12 points of the team in the second promotion position, in any division.
- iii. Teams must satisfy the ground and facilities conditions in respect of the division into which they are to be promoted, and should they fail to do so, the team that finishes highest of the teams that would otherwise be relegated, will not be relegated.
- v. To be eligible for promotion to the Premier division, clubs must meet the requirements of the *Premier Section Ground & Facility Standards* and comply with current ECB Premier League accreditation criteria.
- vi. Clubs promoted to the Championship division will be expected to work towards the requirements of Administrative Rules Appendix 6 *Premier Section Ground & Facility Standards* and current ECB Premier League accreditation criteria.
- iv. Where a team from a club qualifies for promotion into a division in which that club already has a team, the lower division team cannot be promoted, and, subject to ii above, the next eligible team in the lower division may be promoted instead.
- v. Where a team from a club is to be relegated into a division in which that club already has a team, the team in the lower division will also be relegated, in place of the highest team in the relegation places in that division. This process will be repeated in the club also has a team in the lower division into which any of their teams is to be relegated, except where the lower team in in the bottom division, when neither team will be relegated.

- vi. To be eligible to play in Division 2 or above, a club must have a minimum of two Saturday teams.
- vii. The Senior Section cricket committee will have the right to adjust promotion and relegation, as necessary, to take into account new clubs into the League, resignations from the League and clubs admitted to the YCSPL under the pyramid agreement with the Pontefract & District. Promotion and relegation arrangements will be announced at the pre-season clubs meeting before the start of the season.

## **Cup & T20 competitions**

**30 Club entry to cup competitions.** Eligibility for the different cup competitions is as follows:

- i. Whitworth Cup – All 12 Championship Division clubs, the two clubs relegated from the Championship at the end of the previous season, plus the third- and fourth-placed clubs in Division 1 at the end of the previous season (entry is mandatory).
- ii. Mick Savage Trophy. The eight remaining Division 1 teams plus all 12 Division 2 teams (entry is mandatory).
- iii. President's Trophy. Will be open to all teams in Divisions 3 to 5, subject to a maximum of one team per club (entry is optional).
- iv. Billy Oates Memorial Cup. Will be open to all teams in Divisions 6 to 9, subject to a maximum of one team per club (entry is optional).

Where it is necessary to vary the competition into which clubs in Division 1 and below are entered, this will be at the discretion of the Senior Section cricket committee.

- 31 Fixtures.** Games will normally be played on Sundays or Bank Holidays. Where there is a clash with ECB National Club Championship, the latter will take precedence; in the event of a clash with any other cup competition, including the National Village knock-out cup, the YCSPL cup game must take precedence. Otherwise, these dates may only be changed in exceptional circumstances, where agreed by both clubs and the head of the relevant YCSPL Section.
- 32 Concessions and failure to field a team.** A club entered in any League cup or T20 competition that concedes or fails to field a team with less than eight days' notice, will be liable to disqualification from future cup and T20 competitions and a penalty under Administrative Rule 29.

### **33 Whitworth Cup draw arrangements**

- i. All 16 teams enter the competition in Round 1. Eight seeds kept apart in the draw for Round 1. Four seeds play home matches, four seeds play away matches.
- ii. The eight seeds are made up of the teams finishing first to eighth in the Championship Division in the previous season
- iii. Round 1 to be drawn before the start of the season. Each subsequent round an 'open draw' made on the day of the previous round.

### **34 Mick Savage, Presidents & Billy Oates cup draw arrangements**

- i. The number of entrants to each competition varies, but Round 1 must involve enough teams to reduce Round 2 to 16 teams. The number of seeds which receive a bye to Round 2 will vary by the number of entrants.
- ii. Round 2 will follow the principle of Round 1 of the Whitworth Cup, with eight seeds kept apart in the draw for Round 2. Four seeds play home matches, four seeds play away matches. The eight seeds are those entering each competition which finished in the highest positions in the previous season.
- iii. All rounds to be created via an 'open draw' format and the full draw is made before the start of the season, so clubs can see their full pathway.

### **35 T20 Blast & T20 Plate – Group stage arrangements**

- i. Each competition is limited to 12 teams. Four seeds in each competition will be placed in Groups A-D. The other eight teams in each competition will be randomly drawn.
- ii. The four seeds are made up as follows;
  - a. T20 Blast – teams reaching the semi-finals of the T20 Blast in the previous season. Where a team in the previous season is not eligible to compete, the seeding place(s) will be taken by the team(s) finishing highest in YCSPL ECB Premier Division in the previous season.
  - b. T20 Plate – the two teams that played in the previous season's T20 Blast and the two teams reaching the final of the T20 Plate in the previous season. Where a team in the previous season is not eligible to compete or does not enter, the seeding place(s) will be taken by the team(s) finishing highest in YCSPL Championship Division in the previous season.



- iii In both the T20 Blast and Plate, the seeded club will be offered the first opportunity to host the Group Stage.
  - iv Semi-finals of both competitions will be drawn before the start of the season.
- 36 **Reserve dates.** Reserve dates are allocated for cup semi-finals and finals, and the T20 finals day. In the event of a reserve date being required, the organising committee may, in exceptional circumstances, allow that date to be adjusted as long as the game is completed at least seven days before the scheduled date for the next round, where appropriate. Any rearrangement must be authorised by the relevant Section committee by email.
- 37 **Sightscreens.** In the Whitworth Cup and T20 competitions, sightscreens may be black or white.
- 38 **Player eligibility**
- i. Players will only be eligible to play in the cup competitions if, as bona fide registered members of their club, they were eligible to play in the YCSPL by 30 June in that season.
  - ii. A player may only play for one club in any cup competition in a given season.
  - iii. Overseas players and contracted county staff are eligible to play in the competition, provided that they comply with the above and have already appeared in at least one league game for their club before playing in the cup competition.
  - iv. The provisions of rule 16 *Player Selection* above must be followed in relation to team selection for all cup games.
- 39 **Results.** Cup Games cannot be entered as abandoned or cancelled, as a result must be obtained at some time. Summary results, scorecards or other details must not be entered if the game was abandoned, cancelled, or requires a replay. The competition administrator must instead be advised of the date of the re-scheduled game.
- 40 **Finals.** Costs of the finals for the cup and T20 competitions, including balls, teas and umpires, will be met by the League.

# Live-streaming

---

## Filming and live-Streaming of YCSPL games

### *Principles*

The introduction of proportionate controls on the use of live-streaming (including video footage on cameras or mobile phones) and its use on social media is part of general data protection and safeguarding good practice. This guidance should be read in conjunction with the [ECB Live-Streaming guidance](#).

Photographs and videos are considered 'personal data' in terms of the Data Protection Act and GDPR. As with all personal data, it should be processed in accordance with the principles laid out in the Data Protection Act, and other relevant legislation and guidance.

The YCSPL is committed to safeguarding children and helping clubs collect, store and share data appropriately. The ECB Safeguarding policy 'Safe Hands' is available at [www.ecb.co.uk/safeguarding/safeguarding-resources](http://www.ecb.co.uk/safeguarding/safeguarding-resources). The ECB club GDPR guidance is available at [www.ecb.co.uk/news/672545](http://www.ecb.co.uk/news/672545).

### *Action*

#### **Before the game**

- Ensure that your club is shown on the Live-Streaming list (accessed via the front page of the League website) as live-streaming games
- If it is not, advise the [website manager](#) and ask for your club to be shown as live-streaming home games
- It is the responsibility of visiting teams and officials to check the list. Any club or official who does not wish to be streamed must advise the home club at least two days before the game.
- Home clubs must respect the wishes of visiting teams or umpires, and not live-stream games when so requested.
- The written consent from the player or parent/guardian of any junior player (under 16 age group and below) who will play in the game should be held by the team captain and made available for inspection by the opposing captain and/or umpires at the pre-match meeting

#### **At games**

- Clubs should prominently display notices indicating that live-streaming is taking place. For example:

**Please be aware that this game is being filmed by (club name) and the footage may be displayed publicly on websites and social media  
Please contact (insert) if you have any questions or concerns**

- The League's Electronic Media Policy must be observed.
- Live-streaming footage must not be used to criticise or vilify any player or umpire, or be used as a Decision Referral System.
- **Players, officials and spectators must not video games on head-cams, cameras or phones at any time.**
- Play-Cricket confirmation. Within Play-Cricket Scorer Pro is a pop-up box which is triggered before cameras are connected for match highlights or streaming. This pop-up asks the scorer to confirm that both captain and both umpires are happy for the game to be filmed and shared.

#### **After the game**

- Ensure that the use of any video footage is in line with ECB and League policies as above.

#### **Breaches**

- Any breaches of this policy may result in disciplinary action being taken.

#### **Grounds where live-streaming takes place**

Notice of intent to live-stream home games has been given by clubs at the following grounds:

It is the responsibility of visiting teams and officials to check the list. Any club or official who does not wish to be streamed must advise the home club at least two days before the game. Home clubs must respect the wishes of visiting teams and officials and not live-stream games when they so request.

# League playing conditions 2025

---

## 1. General

- i. These playing conditions cover the conduct of games on matchdays in all league games played in the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League. Rules governing these competitions are contained in our [Competition Rules](#). All other League rules are contained in our Administrative Rules document.
- ii. Unless otherwise expressly stated below, all games will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game 2017 Code, the Spirit of Cricket, current ECB regulations, and any relevant YCSPL rules.

## 2. The players (Law 1)

- i. A minimum of seven players will be required to constitute a team. If a side has less than seven players, they will be deemed to have conceded the game.
- ii. Players must be dressed in cricket whites and comply with [Competition Rule 17](#) (Players' attire).

## 3. The umpires (Law 2). A pre-match meeting between captains and umpires will take place no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start time in the Premier Section, or between 15 and 30 minutes before the start time in the Senior Section. At this meeting:

- i. The captain of each side must give their completed and signed team card to the umpires. A Responsible Adult (and deputy) to assess head injuries must be named on each team card.
- ii. In addition:
  - a. the captains and umpires will agree on drinks intervals and any other issues specific to the game,
  - b. both teams must give the umpires a match ball and at least one suitable spare, *and*
  - c. the umpires will advise on the behaviour expected in relation to the Spirit of Cricket, after which captains are asked to advise their players accordingly

#### 4. **The scorers (Law 3)**

- i. Both teams must provide a scorer for all games. Should a team fail to provide a scorer, they must nominate an acting scorer for the whole game from their eleven nominated players. This acting scorer may only be relieved if a suitable alternative scorer (not in the nominated playing XI) is later provided for the remainder of the game. An acting scorer will be allowed to bowl immediately on taking the field.
- ii. Where games are scored manually, the score at the end of each over must be recorded in case of later interruptions due to weather.

#### 5. **The ball (Law 4)**

- i. Red balls of the make and type specified below, must be used in all League games.
- ii. In the Premier Section, the Oxbridge *Windsor* ball will be used; in Divisions 1 & 2, the Reader *Sovereign* ball will be used; and in Divisions 3 to 9, either the Reader *Sovereign* or *League Special* ball will be used.
- iii. A new ball will be used in each innings unless agreed by both captains prior to the start of the innings.
- iv. Lost balls are to be replaced with a ball in similar condition. If the match ball and spare(s) are lost, the home team must provide all additional balls, which must be approved by the umpires. Members of the batting side must help search for any lost balls during play

#### 6. **Maintenance of the playing area (Law 9)**

- i. The pitch may be rolled for a maximum of seven minutes during the interval between innings. The home side must ensure that a suitable roller is available for this purpose. No other rolling of the pitch will be permitted after the toss.
- ii. In the Premier Section, drying equipment, including a soaking machine, forks, and materials to help dry wicket ends, must be available and used on the day of the game whenever necessary.

7. **Covering the pitch (Law 10).** Clubs are responsible for taking all possible action to ensure that play can restart promptly after rain. Where suitable covering is available, pitches, including bowlers' run-ups and wicket-ends, should be covered whenever there is a stoppage due to rain during the game.

## 8. Intervals (Law 11)

- i. A 30-minute break for tea will normally be taken between innings. Where weather interrupts the first innings, the tea interval may be brought forward by the agreement of both captains; in which case there will be an additional 15-minute interval between the two innings.
- ii. One drinks interval will be taken in each innings. This may be dispensed with or added to only with the agreement of both captains.

## 9. Start of play and loss of overs (Law 12)

- i. *Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2.* Unless ground or weather conditions do not allow, all games will commence at 12.00. An early tea can be taken at any time if both captains so agree, but if play has not started by 15.00, an early tea will be taken at that point. No game will start after 16.35.
- ii. *Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9.* Unless ground or weather conditions do not allow, games will commence at 13.00. If play has not started within two and a half hours of the scheduled start time, the game will be cancelled.
- iii. *Rain.* No play will start or restart in rain, i.e., precipitation *falling visibly in separate drops*
- iv. *Late starts.* Overs lost due to late starts will be calculated in accordance with *v* below when the start of the game is delayed either:
  - a. due to ground or weather conditions, *or*
  - b. where three or more members of a team are delayed in arriving at a ground for a bona fide and unavoidable reason, when the start of the game may be delayed, at the request of their team captain, by up to two hours, *or*
  - c. for any other unexpected and unavoidable bona fide reason.
- v. *Overs lost.* Overs lost due to late starts or stoppages in play will be calculated according to time lost, as follows:
  - a. the first 30 minutes lost will be ignored (but see also *vi* below),
  - b. after the first 30 minutes, all time lost after the scheduled start time will be aggregated,
  - c. the 30 minutes allowed for tea will not count as lost playing time, but any additional 15 minutes for the change of innings will count,
  - d. time calculated as lost will result in the deduction of four overs for every complete 15 minutes lost, for example:

<i>Time lost in total</i>	<i>Net loss over 30 mins</i>	<i>Overs deducted</i>
20 mins	Nil	nil
1 hour	30 mins	8
2 hours 25 mins	1 hour 55 mins	28 (10 mins ignored)

- e. in the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, the deductions will be made in accordance with the DLS system,
- f. In the Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9;
- where the interruption occurs in the first innings, half the deduction will be made from each innings, unless there are insufficient overs remaining in the first innings, in which case the overs remaining in that innings will be lost, and the balance deducted from the second innings (any incomplete over in the first innings will be counted as a full over), *or*
  - where the stoppage occurs in the second innings, the full deduction will be made from that innings.
- vi. *Carrying forward time saved in 50-over games.* Where, for whatever reason, the first innings lasts for less than 3 hours 10 minutes, or a proportionately reduced time where overs are reduced, the balance of unused time will be added to the 30 minutes that is allowed before overs are reduced in the second innings. For example, when the first innings lasts for 2 hours 30 minutes and no time has been lost, there is an unused balance of 40 minutes, which means that in the second innings, 1 hour 10 minutes will be allowed before overs are deducted as above.
10. **The toss (Law 13.4/5).** The toss will take place immediately after the pre-match meeting. If a team is not represented at the meeting, the umpires will, at their discretion, award or delay the toss. If no umpires are appointed to the game, the team not represented will be deemed to have lost the toss.

#### 11. **Innings (Law 13)**

- i. The normal duration of play will be:
- a. Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2 - 50 overs per side
  - b. Senior Section Divisions 3 to 5 - 46 overs per side
  - c. Senior Section Divisions 6 to 9 - 40 overs per side
- ii. Any unused overs in the first innings will not be carried forward into the second innings.

- iii. Where bad weather is anticipated later in the day, duration of the game may be reduced, if both captains so agree, before the toss is made. Both captains must agree on the new number of overs to be played, otherwise the full allocated overs must be bowled. For a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 20 overs.

12. **Declarations (Law 15).** No declarations will be allowed.

13. **The result (Law 16)**

- i. For a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 20 overs, unless a result is achieved before that point.
- ii. Where ground and weather conditions restrict play to the extent that a result cannot be achieved in the normal way:
  - a. In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, DLS will be used to determine the result where the two teams do not have the opportunity of batting for the same number of overs.
  - b. In the Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9, where the agreed number of overs cannot be bowled in the second innings, the result will be determined by comparing the score at the end of the last completed over with the score at the end of the same number of overs in the first innings. If the scores are equal at that point, the result will be a tie.

14. **Bowlers' overs (Law 17)**

- i. No bowler must bowl more than one-third of the overs in an innings (fractions of an over to count as one over), with upper limits as follows:
  - a. Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2 – 15 overs
  - b. Senior Section Divisions 3 to 5 – 13 overs
  - c. Senior Section Divisions 6 to 9 – 10 overs
- ii. The upper limits will be reduced pro-rata if the number of overs in the innings is reduced before or after the start. If a bowler has bowled more than their new upper limit before a reduction, their overs bowled will be allowed to stand. The maximum number of overs permitted per bowler will be as follows:



a. Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2:

**15. Penalty runs (Law 18)**

- i. In addition to any penalty runs specified in Law 18.6, penalty runs will be awarded when the bowling side fails to achieve the required over-rate of 16 overs per hour over a completed innings.
- ii. A target time is set for bowling a completed innings as follows:
  - a. Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2 (50 over innings) 3 hours 10 minutes
  - b. Senior Section Divisions 3 to 5 (46-over innings) 2 hours 55 minutes
  - c. Senior Section Divisions 6 to 9 (40-over innings) 2 hours 30 minutes
- iii. These targets will be adjusted pro-rata in the event of the scheduled number of overs in an innings being reduced. The umpires may also at their discretion extend the target time allowed for the innings to compensate for unscheduled stoppages. If the innings is interrupted, the target time will take into account the time lost and any reduction in the number of overs to be bowled.

- iv. Penalty runs will be awarded in the event of the bowling side not being in a position to bowl the first ball of the last over within their target time. In this event, the full quota of overs will be completed, and the batting side will be credited with five runs for each full over remaining to be bowled at the target time. The over in progress at this time will not count. This will apply in both innings of the game.
- v. All penalty runs awarded under this rule will be applied immediately the ball becomes dead after the target time has passed. Play must not continue until the umpires are satisfied that the scorers are of the award of penalty runs and the correct score is displayed on the scoreboard.
- vi. If the side batting second is credited with penalty runs under Law 18, which take their score to, or past, their target, then they will have won the game.
- vii. If the innings ends before the scheduled or re-scheduled target time, no over-rate penalty will apply.

#### **16. Wide balls (Law 22)**

- i. In the Premier Section and Divisions 1 and 2, umpires will apply a consistent and strict interpretation of Law 22.1 in relation to the judging of leg-side wide balls. Any ball passing down the leg side of the striker and outside the line of the leg stump, which does not come into contact with the bat or any part of the striker's person, will be called and signaled 'wide ball' regardless of any movement on the striker's part; other than to play a 'reverse sweep' or 'switch hit.' In the latter circumstances, the ball will not be considered a 'wide ball' simply because it has passed the striker on what would have been their leg-side.
- ii. In the Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9, wide balls will be judged in accordance with Law 22.

#### **17. Fielders' absence (Law 24)**

- i. In the Premier Section and Senior Section Divisions 1 & 2, if a fielder leaves the field during play, or is absent at the start of an innings, they will not incur penalty time under Law 24.2.2 for the first 15 minutes of any absence.
- ii. In the Senior Section Divisions 3-9, the provisions of Law 24.2.2 will not apply, and a fielder may take a full part in the game immediately following a period of absence or late arrival.

**18. Practice on the field of play (Law 26)**

- i. Whilst play is not in progress, practice will be allowed on the playing area, but only up to five minutes before the scheduled time of start or the resumption of play after any interval. Such practice must not take place on the strip being used for the game or the two strips to either side of it. The home team should designate a cut strip on the square and an area on the outfield where the visitors can practice.
- ii. Whilst play is in progress, there will be no practice on the playing area, except that a new bowler will be allowed a maximum of two practice deliveries on the outfield before bowling.
- iii. The umpires have the authority to stop or not allow practice on the playing area if weather conditions mean it may cause damage to the surface.
- iv. Contravention of this rule will result in action being taken by the umpires in accordance with Law 26.4.

**19. Fielding restrictions (Law 28).** In addition to the requirements of Law 28, the following will apply:

- i. *Fielding circles.* Throughout the game, the fielding side must have a minimum of six players, including the wicket keeper and bowler, inside an area which is defined by two semi-circles, each with a radius of 30 yards (27.4m), with their centres being the middle stumps. The ends of each semi-circle will be joined to the other by a straight line drawn on the field on the same side of the pitch. Clubs must use white plastic discs to designate this area; white lines alone are insufficient. Either umpire will call and signal a 'no ball' at the instant of delivery if a fielder infringes this rule.
- ii. *Leg-side fielders.* In Senior Section Divisions 3-9 only, no team must field more than five fielders on the leg-side at any time. In the event of any breach, either umpire should call and signal 'no ball'.

**20. Unfair play (Law 41).** No bowler may bowl more than two short-pitched deliveries in any over, irrespective of who is on strike. 'Short-pitched' is defined as above shoulder height to the striker when standing upright in their crease. The bowlers' end umpire will advise the players verbally and signal when they consider a ball to be 'short-pitched'. Any subsequent short-pitched delivery in that over will be called a 'no ball' and warning action will be taken under Law 41.6.3.

# Cup playing conditions 2025

---

*Applicable to the Whitworth Cup, Mick Savage Trophy, President's Cup and Billy Oates Memorial Cup*

## 1. General

- i. These playing conditions cover the conduct of games on matchdays in both T20 competitions owned by the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League. Rules governing these competitions are contained in our [Competition Rules](#). All other League rules are contained in our Administrative Rules document.
- ii. Unless otherwise expressly stated below, all games will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game 2017 Code, the Spirit of Cricket, current ECB regulations, and relevant YCSPL rules.

## 2. The players (Law 1)

- i. A minimum of seven players will be required to constitute a team. If a side has less than seven players, they will be deemed to have conceded the game.
- ii. In the Whitworth Cup, players must be dressed in coloured cricket clothing, but cricket equipment such as pads and batting gloves are not required to be colour-coordinated (note also that sightscreens may be black or white).
- iii. In the Mick Savage Trophy, President's Cup and Billy Oates Memorial Cup, players must be dressed in cricket whites.
- iv. The provisions of [Competitions Rule 17 \(Players' attire\)](#) must also be followed in all cases.

## 3. The umpires (Law 2). A pre-match meeting between captains and umpires will take place no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start time. At this meeting:

- i. The captain of each side must give their completed and signed team card to the umpires. A Responsible Adult (and deputy) to assess head injuries must be named on each team sheet.
- ii. In addition:
  - a. the captains and umpires will agree on any other issues specific to the game,
  - b. both teams must give the umpires a match ball and at least one suitable spare, *and*

- c. the umpires will advise on the behaviour expected in relation to the Spirit of Cricket, after which captains are asked to advise their players accordingly

#### 4. **The scorers (Law 3).**

- i Both teams must provide a scorer for all games. Should a team fail to provide a scorer, they must nominate a scorer for the whole game from their eleven nominated players. This acting scorer may only be relieved if a suitable alternative scorer (not in the nominated playing XI) is later provided. An acting scorer will be allowed to bowl immediately on taking the field.
- ii Where games are scored manually, the score at the end of each over must be recorded in case of later interruptions due to weather.

#### 5. **The ball (Law 4)**

- i. In the Whitworth Cup, the pink Dukes *County International* ball will be used.
- ii. In the Mick Savage Trophy, the red Reader *Sovereign* ball will be used.
- iii. In the President's Cup and Billy Oates Memorial Cup, either the red Reader *Sovereign* or *League Special* ball will be used.
- iv. A new ball will be used in each innings.
- v. Lost balls are to be replaced with a ball in similar condition. If the match ball and spare(s) are lost, the home team must provide all additional balls, which must be approved by the umpires. Members of the batting side must help search for any lost balls during play

6. **The creases (Law 7).** In the Whitworth Cup and the Mick Savage Trophy, to assist the umpires in judging wide balls, pitches must be marked with the 17" lines.

#### 7. **Maintenance of the playing area (Law 9)**

- i. The pitch may be rolled for a maximum of seven minutes during the interval between innings. The home side must ensure that a suitable roller is available for this purpose. No other rolling of the pitch will be permitted after the toss.
- ii. In the Whitworth Cup, drying equipment, including a soaking machine, forks, and materials to help dry wicket ends, must be available and used on the day of the game whenever necessary.

8. **Covering the pitch (Law 10).** Clubs are responsible for taking all possible action to ensure that play can restart promptly after rain. Where suitable covering is available, pitches, including bowlers' run-ups and wicket-ends, should be covered whenever there is a stoppage due to rain during the game.
9. **Intervals (Law 11)**
- A 30-minute break for tea will normally be taken between innings. Where weather interrupts the first innings, the tea interval may be brought forward by the agreement of both captains; in which case there will be an additional 15-minute interval between the two innings.
  - If the innings of the side batting first is completed more than 60 minutes prior to the scheduled interval, then a 15-minute break will occur, and the team batting second will commence their innings and the interval will occur as scheduled.
  - In the event of time being lost the umpires have the discretion to reduce the length of the interval.
  - One drinks interval will be taken in each innings. This may be dispensed with or added to only with the agreement of both captains. Any drinks break should not last more than five minutes.
  - If the number of overs in an innings is reduced to 20 overs or less because of delays or interruptions, there will be no interval for drinks.
  - In all cases the time taken for drinks is included in the playing time for that innings.
10. **Start of play and loss of overs (Law 12)**
- Start times.* All cup games, including finals, will start at 12.30pm (except where a delayed start of up to one hour is requested by the home club in order to accommodate a junior or W&G section game).
  - The total match time, including the interval, should be no longer than five hours 50 minutes.
  - Rain.* No play will start or restart in rain, i.e. precipitation falling visibly in separate drops.
  - Late starts.* Overs lost due to late starts will be calculated in accordance with v. below when the start of the game is delayed either:
    - due to ground or weather conditions, *or*
    - where three or more members of a team are delayed in arriving at a ground for a bona fide and unavoidable reason, when the start of the

game may be delayed, at the request of their team captain, by up to two hours, *or*

- c. for any other unexpected and unavoidable bona fide reason.
- v. *Overs lost.* Overs lost due to late starts or stoppages in play will be calculated according to time lost as follows:
  - a. the first 30 minutes lost will be ignored (but see also *vi.* below),
  - b. after the first 30 minutes, all time lost after the scheduled start time will be aggregated,
  - c. the 30 minutes allowed for tea will not count as lost playing time, but any additional 15 minutes for the change of innings will count,
  - d. time calculated as lost will result in the deduction of four overs for every complete 15 minutes lost after the first 30 minutes. For example:

<i>Time lost in total</i>	<i>Net loss over 30 mins</i>	<i>Overs deducted</i>
20 mins	Nil	nil
1 hour	30 mins	8
2 hours 25 mins	1 hour 55 mins	28 (10 mins ignored)

- e. in the Whitworth Cup, Mick Savage Trophy and all Cup Finals, the deductions will be made in accordance with the DLS system and will, where possible, be made so that the innings are of equal length.
- f. in the Presidents Trophy and the Billy Oates Memorial Cup (except in the finals);
  - where the interruption occurs in the first innings, half the deduction will be made from each innings, unless there are insufficient overs remaining in the first innings, in which case the overs remaining in that innings will be lost, and the balance deducted from the second innings (any incomplete over in the first innings will be counted as a full over), *or*
  - where the stoppage occurs in the second innings, the full deduction will be made from that innings
- vii. *Carrying forward time saved in 40-over games.* Where, for whatever reason, the first innings lasts for less than 2 hours 40 minutes, or a proportionately reduced time where overs are reduced, the balance of unused time will be added to the 30 minutes that is allowed before overs are reduced in the second innings. For example, when the first innings lasts for 2 hours 20 minutes and no time has been lost, there is an unused balance of 20 minutes, which means that in the second innings, 50 minutes will be allowed before overs are deducted as above.

11. **The toss (Law 13.4/5).** The toss will take place immediately after the pre-match meeting. If a team is not represented at the meeting, the umpires will, at their discretion, award or delay the toss. If no umpires are appointed to the game, the team not represented will be deemed to have lost the toss.
12. **Innings (Law 13)**
- i. The normal duration of play will be 40 overs per innings for all cup competitions, unless the overs are reduced as per iii. below.
  - ii. Any unused overs in the first innings will not be carried forward into the second innings.
  - iii. Where bad weather is anticipated later in the day, duration of the game may be reduced, if both captains so agree, before the toss is made. Both captains must agree on the new number of overs to be played, otherwise the full allocated overs must be bowled. For a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 10 overs.
  - iv. All sides are expected to be in position to bowl the first ball of the last of their 40 overs within 2 hours 40 minutes playing time (including time taken for drinks). In the event of them failing to do so:
    - a. One fewer fielder will be permitted outside the fielding restriction area in rule 20.i than would normally be the case in the over in progress at the time. All penalties in this regard will be imposed immediately the ball first becomes dead after the scheduled or re-scheduled cessation time for the innings.
    - b. The full quota of overs will be completed.
    - c. The umpire will inform the fielding team captain, when taking the field for the first time and on every subsequent occasion if play is interrupted, of the scheduled cessation time for that innings. The umpire at the bowler's end will inform the fielding captain, the batter and their fellow umpire of any time allowances as and when they arise (this matter will not be subject to retrospective negotiation).
  - v. If the innings is terminated before the scheduled or re-scheduled cut-off time, no over rate penalty will apply. If the innings is interrupted, the over-rate penalty will apply based on the re-scheduled cessation time for that innings.
  - vi. In addition, in all reduced overs matches, the fielding team will be given one over's leeway. For the avoidance of doubt, one over's leeway means that the fielding side must be in position to bowl the first ball of the penultimate over by the scheduled or rescheduled 'cut-off' time.



- iv. Over-rate penalties apply only to innings of 15 overs or more duration. This is the only penalty for a slow over-rate.

**13. Declarations (Law 15).** No declarations will be allowed.

**14. The result (Law 16)**

- i. For a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of 10 overs, unless a result is achieved before that point.
- ii. In games where there has been no reduction of overs after the start, the winner will be the team scoring the most runs. If the scores are tied at the completion of a match, the side losing the fewer wickets shall be adjudged the winner.
- iii. If the result cannot be decided by 14 ii. above, the winner will be the side with the higher score:
  - a. after 30 overs, *or if still equal*,
  - b. after 20 overs, *or if still equal*,
  - c. after 10 overs.
- iv. Where overs are reduced after a match commences, or in abandoned games where both teams have an opportunity to bat for more than ten overs:
  - a. In the Whitworth Cup, Mick Savage Trophy and all Cup Finals, DLS will be used to achieve a result. Wherever possible, the DLS par score should be displayed on the scoreboard from the start of the second innings or, if later, from the point from which DLS comes into operation.
  - b. In the President's Cup and the Billy Oates Memorial Cup, the result will be determined by comparing the score at the end of the last completed over with the score at the end of the same number of overs in the first innings. If the scores are equal at that point, 14 vi will apply. It is necessary, therefore, where DLS is not being used, for scorers to note the score at the end of each over in the first innings.
- v. Where a result cannot be achieved on the field up to and including the quarter-final stage, the game will be decided by a 'bowl out' or 'coin toss'. In the semi-finals and final, the game will be rearranged or replayed.

**15. Bowlers' overs (Law 17)**

- i. No bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the number of overs scheduled for the innings.

- ii. In innings where the overs are reduced, no bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the total overs allowed (unless such a number has been exceeded before the interruption), except that where the total overs are not divisible by five, an additional over will be allowed to the minimum number of bowlers necessary to make up the balance - e.g. an innings is reduced to 32 overs, two bowlers can bowl seven overs and three bowlers can bowl six overs.
- iii. When an interruption occurs mid-over and on resumption the bowler has exceeded the new maximum allocation, they will be allowed to finish the incomplete over.

#### **16. No balls (Law 21)**

- i. Regardless of how wide of the striker a delivery is, there will be no more than two deliveries per over that after pitching pass or would have passed clearly over shoulder height of the striker standing upright at the popping crease.
- ii. The umpire will make it clear to the bowler (and any bowler called upon to complete an over) and the striker when a delivery within the limit in 16.i has been bowled. It is unfair if the limit is exceeded, and the umpire will call and signal 'no ball' on each such occasion and consider it as part of the warning sequence in Laws 41.6.3 and 41.6.4.
- iii. If a bowler is 'no-balled' a second time in the innings for breaching 16.i & ii, the umpire will invoke Law 41.6.4, the bowler will be removed immediately and will not be allowed to bowl again in that innings.

#### **17. Free hits**

- i. The delivery following a 'no ball' will be a free hit for whichever batter is facing it. This applies to all modes of 'no ball' except for short-pitched deliveries that pass, or would clearly have passed, over head-height of the striker standing upright on the popping crease.
- ii. The umpires will signal a free hit (after the normal 'no ball' signal) by extending one arm straight upwards and moving it in a circular motion.
- iii. If the delivery for the free hit is not a legitimate delivery (any kind of 'no ball' or a 'wide ball'), then the next delivery will become a free hit for whichever batter is facing it.
- iv. For any free hit, the striker can be dismissed only under the circumstances that apply for a 'no ball', even if the delivery for the free hit is called a 'wide ball'.

- v. Field changes are not permitted for free hit deliveries unless there is a change of striker, or the 'no ball' was the result of a field restriction breach in which case the field may be changed to the extent of correcting the breach. However, in all circumstances, any fielder within 15 yards of the striker may retreat to a position on the same line no more than 15 yards from the striker.

#### **18. Wide balls (Law 22)**

- i. In the Whitworth Cup and Mick Savage Trophy, umpires are instructed to apply a very strict and consistent interpretation in regard to this Law in order to prevent negative bowling wide of the wicket. Any offside or legside delivery which in the opinion of the umpire does not give the batter a reasonable opportunity to score shall be called a wide. For guidance purposes, a legside wide shall be called if a ball passes on the legside outside the pads of the batter standing in a normal batting position.
- ii. In the President's Cup and Billy Oates Memorial Cup, wide balls will be judged in accordance with Law 22.

#### **19. Fielders' absence**

- i. In the Whitworth Cup and Mick Savage Trophy, if a fielder leaves the field during play, or is absent at the start of an innings, they will not incur penalty time under Law 24.2.2 for the first 15 minutes of absence.
- ii. In the President's Cup and Billy Oates Memorial Cup, the provisions of Law 24.2.2 will not apply, and a fielder may take a full part in the game immediately following a period of absence or late arrival. The captain must inform the umpires immediately of the arrival of a late player.

#### **20. Practice on the field of play (Law 26)**

- i. Whilst play is not in progress, practice will be allowed on the playing area, but only up to five minutes before the scheduled time of start or the resumption of play after any interval. Such practice must not take place on the strip being used for the game or the two strips to either side of it. The home team should designate a cut strip on the square and an area on the outfield where the visitors can practice.
- ii. Whilst play is in progress, there will be no practice on the playing area, except that a new bowler will be allowed a maximum of two practice deliveries on the outfield before bowling.
- iii. The umpires have the authority to stop or not allow practice on the playing area if weather conditions mean it may cause damage to the surface.

- iv. Contravention of this rule will result in action being taken by the umpires in accordance with Law 26.4.
21. **Fielding restrictions (Law 28).** In addition to the requirements of Law 28, the following will apply:
- i. *Leg-side fielders.* At the instant of delivery, there may not be more than 5 fielders on the leg-side.
  - ii. *Fielding circles.* Two semi-circles will be drawn on the field of play, each with a radius of 30 yards (27.4m), with their centres being the middle stumps. The ends of each semi-circle will be joined to the other by a straight line drawn on the field on the same side of the pitch. Clubs must use white plastic discs to designate this area; white lines alone are insufficient.
  - iii. In the Whitworth Cup and Mick Savage Trophy, Powerplays will apply. In Powerplays the following fielding restrictions will apply at the instant of delivery:
    - a. Powerplay 1 – no more than two fielders will be permitted outside the fielding circle. In an innings of 40 overs, these are overs 1 to 8 inclusive.
    - b. Powerplay 2 – no more than four fielders will be permitted outside the fielding circle. In an innings of 40 overs, these are overs 9 to 32 inclusive.
    - c. Powerplay 3 – no more than five fielders will be permitted outside the fielding circle. In an innings of 40 overs, these are overs 33 to 40 inclusive.
  - iv. In circumstances when the number of overs of the batting team is reduced, the number of overs within each phase (Powerplay) of the innings will be reduced in accordance with the table in 22 below. For clarity, the table will apply to both innings of the match.
  - v. If play is interrupted during an innings, overs are reduced and the table in the 22 below is applied, the Powerplay overs take immediate effect. For the avoidance of doubt this applies even if the interruption has occurred mid-over.

- vi. Power plays will not apply in the President's Cup and the Billy Oates Memorial Cup. Fielding restrictions in these competitions will be as in Senior Section Divisions 3 to 9, i.e., six players within the fielding circle at all times.
- vii. In the event of any breach of the above, either umpire should call and signal 'no ball'.

22. **Powerplay overs when number of overs in innings is reduced.** In circumstances when the number of overs of the batting team is reduced (rule 21.iv), the number of overs within each phase (Powerplay) of the innings will be reduced in accordance with the table below. For the sake of clarity, it should be noted that the table will apply to both the first and second innings of the match.

# T20 playing conditions 2025

---

## 1. General

- i. These playing conditions cover the conduct of games on matchdays in both T20 competitions owned by the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League. Rules governing these competitions are contained in our [Competition Rules](#). All other League rules are contained in our Administrative Rules document.
- ii. Unless otherwise expressly stated below, all games will be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game 2017 Code, the Spirit of Cricket, current ECB regulations, and relevant YCSPL rules.

## 2. The players (Law 1)

- i. A minimum of seven players will be required to constitute a team. If a side has less than seven players, they will be deemed to have conceded the game.
- ii. Players must be dressed in coloured cricket clothing, but cricket equipment such as pads and batting gloves are not required to be colour-coordinated (note also that sightscreens may be black or white).
- iii. The provisions of [Competitions Rule 17](#) (Players' attire) must also be followed in all cases.

## 3. The umpires (Law 2). A pre-match meeting between captains and umpires will take place no later than 15 minutes before the scheduled start time, at this meeting:

- i. The captain of each side must give their completed and signed team card to the umpires. A Responsible Adult (and deputy) to assess head injuries must be named on each team sheet.
- ii. In addition:
  - a. the captains and umpires will agree on any other issues specific to the game,
  - b. both teams must give the umpires a match ball and at least one suitable spare, *and*
  - c. the umpires will advise on the behaviour expected in relation to the Spirit of Cricket, after which captains are asked to advise their players accordingly

4. **The scorers (Law 3).** Both teams must provide a scorer for all games, which will be scored digitally. Should a team fail to provide a scorer, they must nominate a scorer for the whole game from their eleven nominated players. This acting scorer may only be relieved if a suitable alternative scorer (not in the nominated playing XI) is later provided. An acting scorer will be allowed to bowl immediately on taking the field.
5. **The ball (Law 4)**
  - i. The pink Oxbridge *Magna* ball will be used.
  - ii. A new ball will be used in each innings.
  - iii. Lost balls are to be replaced with a ball in similar condition. If the match ball and spare(s) are lost, the home team must provide all additional balls, which must be approved by the umpires. Members of the batting side must help search for any lost balls during play
6. **The creases (Law 7).** To assist the umpires in judging wide balls, pitches must be marked with the 17" lines.
7. **Maintenance of the playing area (Law 9)**
  - i. The pitch may be rolled for a maximum of seven minutes during the interval between innings. The home side must ensure that a suitable roller is available for this purpose. No other rolling of the pitch will be permitted after the toss.
  - ii. Drying equipment, including a soaking machine, forks, and materials to help dry wicket ends, must be available and used on the day of the game whenever necessary.
8. **Covering the pitch (Law 10).** Clubs are responsible for taking all possible action to ensure that play can restart promptly after rain. Where suitable covering is available, pitches, including bowlers' run-ups and wicket-ends, should be covered whenever there is a stoppage due to rain during the game.
9. **Intervals (Law 11).** A 15-minute interval will normally be taken between innings. Where weather interrupts the first innings, the interval may be brought forward by the agreement of both captains; in which case there will be an additional 10-minute interval between the two innings.

## 10. Start of play and loss of overs (Law 12)

- i. *Start times.* Target start times for games will be notified by the competition organiser in advance.
- ii. The total match time, including the interval, should be no longer than two hours 45 minutes.
- iii. *Rain.* No play will start or restart in rain, i.e. precipitation *falling visibly in separate drops.*
- iv. *Overs lost.* Overs lost due to late starts or stoppages in play will be calculated according to time lost as follows:
  - a. all time lost after the scheduled start time will be aggregated,
  - b. the first 30 minutes lost will be ignored,
  - c. the 15 minutes allowed for the interval will not count as lost playing time, but any additional time for the change of innings will count,
  - d. time calculated as lost will result in the deduction of four overs for every complete 15 minutes lost after the first 30 minutes,
  - e. deductions will, where possible, be made so that the innings are of equal length; where the interruption occurs in the first innings, half the deduction will be made from each innings, unless there are insufficient overs remaining in the first innings, in which case the overs remaining in that innings will be lost, and the balance deducted from the second innings (any incomplete over in the first innings will be counted as a full over),
  - f. where the stoppage occurs in the second innings, the full deduction will be made from that innings.
- v. *Carrying forward time saved.* Where, for whatever reason, the first innings lasts for less than 1 hours 15 minutes, or a proportionately reduced time where overs are reduced, the balance of unused time will be added to the time that is allowed before overs are reduced in the second innings. For example, when the first innings lasts for 1 hours and no time has been lost, there is an unused balance of 15 minutes, which will be allowed before overs are deducted from the second innings as above.

11. **The toss (Law 13.4/5).** The toss will take place immediately after the pre-match meeting. If a team is not represented at the meeting, the umpires will, at their discretion, award or delay the toss.

## 12. Innings (Law 13)

- i. The normal duration of play will be 20 overs per innings for all cup competitions, unless the overs are reduced as per iii. below.



- ii. Any unused overs in the first innings will not be carried forward into the second innings.
- iii. Where bad weather is anticipated later in the day, duration of the game may be reduced, if both captains so agree, before the toss is made. Both captains must agree on the new number of overs to be played, otherwise the full allocated overs must be bowled. For a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of five overs.
- iv. All sides are expected to be in position to bowl the first ball of the last of their 20 overs within 1 hours 15 minutes playing time. In the event of them failing to do so:
  - a. One fewer fielder will be permitted outside the fielding restriction area in rule 20.ii than would normally be the case in the over in progress at the time. All penalties in this regard will be imposed immediately the ball first becomes dead after the scheduled or re-scheduled cessation time for the innings.
  - b. The full quota of overs will be completed.
  - c. The umpire will inform the fielding team captain when taking the field for the first time and on every subsequent occasion if play is interrupted, the scheduled cessation time for that innings. The umpire at the bowler's end will inform the fielding captain, the batter and their fellow umpire of any time allowances as and when they arise (this matter will not be subject to retrospective negotiation).
- v. If the innings is terminated before the scheduled or re-scheduled cut-off-time, no over rate penalty will apply. If the innings is interrupted, the over-rate penalty will apply based on the re-scheduled cessation time for that innings.
- vi. In addition, in all reduced overs matches, the fielding team will be given one over's leeway. For the avoidance of doubt, one over's leeway means that the fielding side must be in position to bowl the first ball of the penultimate over by the scheduled or rescheduled 'cut-off' time.
- vii. Over-rate penalties apply only to innings of 10 overs or more duration. This is the only penalty for a slow over-rate.

**13. Declarations (Law 15).** No declarations will be allowed.

#### 14. The result (Law 16)

- i. For a result to be achieved, both sides must have had the opportunity of batting for a minimum of five overs, unless a result is achieved before that point.
- ii. In games where there has been no reduction of overs after the start, the winner will be the team scoring the most runs. If the scores are tied, the side losing the fewest wickets will be the winner. If the scores and lost wickets are equal in group stage games the result will be a tie.
- iii. Where overs are reduced after a match commences, or in abandoned games where both teams have an opportunity to bat for more than five overs, DLS will be used to achieve a result.
- iv. Where a result cannot be achieved on the field in the semi-finals and final, the game will be rearranged or replayed. Where this cannot be accommodated, the result will be achieved by a bowl-out or coin-toss.

#### 15. Bowlers' overs (Law 17)

- i. No bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the number of overs scheduled for the innings.
- ii. However, in a delayed or interrupted match, where the overs are reduced for both sides, or for the side bowling second, no bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the total overs allowed (unless such a number has been exceeded before the interruption), except that where the total overs are not divisible by five, an additional over shall be allowed to the minimum number of bowlers necessary to make up the balance.

*For example, after eight overs, rain interrupts play and the innings is reduced to 12 overs. Both opening bowlers have bowled four overs. Two bowlers can bowl 3 overs and three bowlers can bowl 2 overs. Bowlers 1 and 2 have already exceeded this limit. They count as the two bowlers who were allowed the extra over, so any other bowlers are limited to two overs.*

- iii. For innings of rescheduled length of between five and nine overs, no bowler may bowl more than two overs. In these circumstances, the one-fifth limit does not apply.
- iv. When an interruption occurs mid-over and on resumption the bowler has exceeded the new maximum allocation, they will be allowed to finish the incomplete over.
- v. In the event of a bowler breaking down and being unable to complete an over, another bowler will bowl the remaining balls. Such part of an over will count as a full over only in so far as each bowler's limit is concerned.

## 16. No balls (Law 21)

- i. Regardless of how wide of the striker a delivery is, there will be no more than one delivery per over that after pitching pass or would have passed clearly over shoulder height of the striker standing upright at the popping crease.
- ii. The umpire will make it clear to the bowler (and any bowler called upon to complete an over) and the striker when a delivery within the limit in 16.i has been bowled. It is unfair if the limit is exceeded, and the umpire will call and signal 'no ball' on each such occasion and consider it as part of the warning sequence in Laws 41.6.3 and 41.6.4.
- iii. If a bowler is 'no-balled' a second time in the innings for breaching 16.i & ii, the umpire will invoke Law 41.6.4, the bowler will be removed immediately and will not be allowed to bowl again in that innings.

## 17. Free hits

- i. The delivery following a 'no ball' will be a free hit for whichever batter is facing it. This applies to all modes of 'no ball' except for short-pitched deliveries that pass, or would clearly have passed, over head-height of the striker standing upright on the popping crease.
- ii. The umpires will signal a free hit (after the normal 'no ball' signal) by extending one arm straight upwards and moving it in a circular motion.
- iii. If the delivery for the free hit is not a legitimate delivery (any kind of 'no ball' or a 'wide ball'), then the next delivery will become a free hit for whichever batter is facing it.
- iv. For any free hit, the striker can be dismissed only under the circumstances that apply for a 'no ball', even if the delivery for the free hit is called a 'wide ball'.
- v. Field changes are not permitted for free hit deliveries unless there is a change of striker, or the 'no ball' was the result of a field restriction breach in which case the field may be changed to the extent of correcting the breach. However, in all circumstances, any fielder within 15 yards of the striker may retreat to a position on the same line no more than 15 yards from the striker.

18. **Wide balls (Law 22).** Umpires are instructed to apply a very strict and consistent interpretation in regard to this Law in order to prevent negative bowling wide of the wicket. Any offside or legside delivery which in the opinion of the umpire does not give the batter a reasonable opportunity to score shall be called a wide. For guidance purposes, a legside wide shall be called if a ball passes on the legside outside the pads of the batter standing in a normal batting position.
19. **Practice on the field of play (Law 26)**
- i. Whilst play is not in progress, practice will be allowed on the playing area, but only up to five minutes before the scheduled time of start or the resumption of play after any interval. Such practice must not take place on the strip being used for the game or the two strips to either side of it. The home team should designate a cut strip on the square and an area on the outfield where the visitors can practice.
  - ii. Whilst play is in progress, there will be no practice on the playing area, except that a new bowler will be allowed a maximum of two practice deliveries on the outfield before bowling.
  - iii. The umpires have the authority to stop or not allow practice on the playing area if weather conditions mean it may cause damage to the surface.
  - iv. Contravention of this rule will result in action being taken by the umpires in accordance with Law 26.4.
20. **Fielding restrictions (Law 28).** In addition to the requirements of Law 28, the following will apply:
- i. *Leg-side fielders.* At the instant of delivery, there may not be more than 5 fielders on the leg-side.
  - iii. *Fielding circles.* Two semi-circles will be drawn on the field of play, each with a radius of 30 yards (27.4m), with their centres being the middle stumps. The ends of each semi-circle will be joined to the other by a straight line drawn on the field on the same side of the pitch. Clubs must use white plastic discs to designate this area; white lines alone are insufficient.
    - a. For the first 6 overs of each innings only two fielders are permitted to be outside the fielding circle at the instant of delivery. Fielding circle to be 30 yards.
    - b. For the remaining overs of each innings only five fielders are permitted to be outside the fielding circle at the instant of delivery.

- c. In circumstances when the number of overs of the batting team is reduced, the number of Fielding Restriction Overs shall be reduced in accordance with the table below. For the sake of clarity, it should be noted that the table shall apply to both innings of the match.

<i>Total Overs</i>	<i>No. of overs for which fielding restrictions apply</i>
5 – 6	1
7 – 9	2
10 – 13	3
14 – 16	4
17 – 19	5

- iv. In the event of any breach of the above, either umpire should call and signal 'no ball'.

### **Bowl-out procedure**

Where a result cannot be obtained by other methods, and where there is no reserve date on which to play the game, a bowl-out (outdoors or indoors) will take place to achieve a result. Five players from each side will bowl two overarm deliveries each at a wicket (conforming to Law 8) from a wicket pitched at a distance of 22 yards with, if practicable, bowling, popping and return creases marked (conforming to Law 7).

The side that bowls down the wicket (as defined in Law 29.1.1) the most times, shall be the winner. If the scores are equal, the same players will bowl one ball each alternately to achieve a result on a 'sudden death' basis.

The following shall also apply in respect of bowl-outs:

- The same suitably acceptable ball (not a new one) will be used by both teams. If this ball becomes wet, it may be changed subject to the umpires' approval.
- If a bowler bowls a 'no ball' it will count as one of the two deliveries but will not count towards the score of the team.
- If the original match has started, then the five cricketers nominated to take part in the bowl-out must be chosen from the eleven cricketers and 12th man selected to play in the match. If there has been no play in the original match (and the toss has not taken place), the five cricketers may be selected from any of the players in the squad as registered on Play-Cricket.
- Each side will appoint a wicket-keeper to stand behind the wicket but out of reach of the stumps.

## Hall of Fame

---

The *Hall of Fame* was introduced by the Yorkshire South Premier League to recognise individuals who 'have given outstanding service to our clubs or our league'. Carried forward into the YCSPL, it covers the whole league, and its' members are:

1. **Bill Croft.** Former Sheffield Collegiate CC seam bowler and tireless committee worker, who became President of the Yorkshire League.
2. **Steve Foster.** One of the finest cricketers produced in Yorkshire not to play in the first-class game. An outstanding all-rounder for Treeton CC.
3. **Andy Harrison.** Yorkshire League opening bowler with Rotherham Town CC, who then captained Wickersley Old Village CC to seven South Yorkshire titles.
4. **Bob Leafe.** Cleethorpes CC's record run-scorer, who served the club for over fifty years as player, captain, committee member and cricket chairman.
5. **Stuart Roberts.** A former Conisborough CC batsman who became one of Yorkshire's best umpires, serving over thirty years on the Premier League panel.
6. **Dennis Wadd.** Appleby Frodingham CC's first team scorer for 54 years; a meticulous scorer and an ever-popular figure before passing away in 2022.
7. **Nick Cowan.** A Yorkshire League legend who led first Rotherham Town then Doncaster Town to League titles; leading the latter to the 1998 National Club Championship. A familiar figure at DTCC until passing away in December 2023.
8. **Keith Haynes.** Former Treeton CC stalwart who served 31 years as club chairman and was the driving force behind making the club what it is today.
9. **Richard Wilkinson.** A stalwart all-rounder at Barnsley, Whitley Hall and Wombwell Main, whose vast experience now benefits the YCB.
10. **Matt Dixon.** Served for 12 years as captain of Sheffield Collegiate CC; who was closely involved in the creation of the YSPL, of which he became vice-chairman.
11. **Harry Fidler.** A popular and respected 'old school' umpire who served 16 years on the Premier League panel and was noted for never refusing an appointment.
12. **Kevin Motley.** A dedicated and meticulous scorer for Barnsley CC for many seasons, recognised as one of the best in the country, who passed away in 2023.
13. **Terry Bentham.** Legendary League Ambassador whose dedicated contribution to administration and umpiring in South Yorkshire cricket covered over 40 years.
14. **Steve Fletcher.** 'Mr Whitley Hall', whose enormous contribution to the club in every possible role over 53 years before he passed away in 2022.
15. **Iain Mallett.** Has served Millhouses Works CC for over 30 years in numerous roles, his legacies include the club's junior structure and splendid new pavilion.
16. **Steve Reid.** A loyal servant of Penistone CC for 47 years, in particular, coaching juniors and as club groundsman, who passed away in 2021.
17. **Milton Samuels.** The hugely-respected first chair of the League's Equity & Diversity Group, the founder and driving force behind British Caribbean Sports CC.



18. **Richard Storer.** Club secretary at Hallam CC for 35 years and driving force behind its' growth into one of the country's leading producers of junior players.
19. **Mark Beardshall.** Opening bowler with Derbyshire CCC, who played with distinction in the Bradford, Huddersfield and Yorkshire Leagues; a long-serving vice-chairman of Barnsley Woolley Miners CC and YCSPL committee member.
20. **Mick Bocking.** Served Bradfield Village Fellowship CC for over 30 years as player, administrator and groundsman and is a key part of the YCSPL disciplinary team.
21. **Peter Holes.** Upper-order batsman who went on to serve Norton Oakes CC for 50 years in almost every role, including setting up its thriving junior section.
22. **Ian Swallow.** After starting a distinguished 50-year playing career at Elsecar CC, he returned to lead his 'home club' to the *Black Sheep* Yorkshire Championship via Yorkshire CCC, Somerset CCC, and Meltham CC in the Huddersfield League.
23. **Mark Wilson.** A metronomic medium-fast bowler for Wath CC for over 40 years, who has gone on to represent Yorkshire and England over 50s.
24. **Ann Burdett.** Always a welcoming face at Shiregreen CC, where she has now provided the teas for players and officials for over sixty years.
25. **David Clayton.** An attacking middle order batsman for Frecheville Community CC for many years, and for over 15 years its' chairman and groundsman.
26. **Brian Fletcher.** A stalwart committee member of the South Yorkshire Senior Cricket League for 37 years, the last seven as President.
27. **Martin Ivill.** An opening bowler who made his senior debut aged 12 at Wombwell Main, then played with great distinction for Barnsley CC and Sheffield Collegiate CC before going on to play for Yorkshire over 60s.
28. **Brian Sissons.** An all-rounder and brilliant captain with Rotherham Phoenix CC, he then served Phoenix and Tickhill CC tirelessly off the field.
29. **Daniel Bamforth.** The force behind the establishment of the disability hub at Higham CC and behind the club's new clubhouse and ground improvements.
30. **Roger Fairhurst.** Long-serving Oughtibridge WMCC groundsman who helped the club overcome the flood damage of 2007 and established its reputation for excellent pitches.
31. **Nick Gaywood.** Prolific Sheffield Collegiate CC and Devon CCC opening batsman who played a leading role in Collegiates' golden years between 1990 and 2002.
32. **Malc Shaw.** Has served Aston Hall CC for over 50 years, first as an outstanding all-rounder and club captain, then on the club committee, where he became chairman.
33. **Andrew Tipple.** Popular scorer, latterly with Whitley Hall and Wakefield Thornes, whose dedication and enthusiasm extends far wider than the scoreboard.
