## YCSPL Annual General Meeting 2024

The League AGM will take place on Wednesday 13 November in the Griffin Suite at Shaw Lane Sports Club, Barnsley, at 7.00pm. All clubs in membership must be represented.

Full documentation will be issued to all clubs by 23 October. This will include proposed rule changes and nominations for the League Executive Board (LEB) and the Section Committees.

The biggest proposed changes at the AGM will be to the constitution, to:

- confirm the adoption of Sport England's [Code of Sports Governance](#) (CoSG), as required by ECB, and the changes required to make the League compliant
- fully incorporate the Womens & Girls' League (WGL) into our structure

For the League, the most significant consequence of the CoSG adoption is that members of the main decision-making body of the League (the LEB) will normally be allowed to serve for a maximum of nine years, rather than indefinitely as now.

To accommodate this, we are recommending that the LEB comprises three representatives of each of the Premier, Senior and WGL committees, plus the Safeguarding Manager; with representatives of the Equity & Diversity Group and the YCB co-opted on a non-executive basis. One of the full members will be elected as chair. This will enable current LEB members such as the Compliance Manager, Participation Manager, Scoring Manager and Treasurer to remain in their roles without restriction.

The members and chair of the newly-constituted LEB will be elected at the AGM, and must be proposed and seconded either by the existing LEB members or clubs in membership of the League.

The Section Committees will continue as before, and members must be proposed and seconded either by the existing committee members or clubs in membership of the League, for vote at the AGM.

Clubs are now also invited to make proposals for rule changes. These must be seconded by either another club or existing member of the LEB.

**All proposals and nominations must be sent to me in accordance with the above, and received by Saturday 12 October.**

The operational implications of the full incorporation of the WGL into our structure are currently being examined, but the existing WGL playing conditions will not be affected. We will update on this issue at the AGM.
