



- Of the 132 scheduled league games, there was play in 118 (89.4%) and a result was achieved in 111 (84.1%)
- Results were achieved in all games at Appleby Frodingham, Doncaster Town and Wickersley Old Village
- Of the 111 results, DLS was utilised in six (5.4%)
- Sides winning the toss elected to bat first in 73 games (61.9%) and bowl first in 45 (38.1%); most sides elected to bat first at Wickersley (nine out of eleven); and most elected to bowl first at Cawthorne (six out of ten)
- Where a result was achieved, the side batting first won in 59 games (53.2%) and the side batting second won 52 (46.8%); most games were won by the side batting first at Barnsley (seven out of nine) and Doncaster (seven out of ten) and by the side batting second at Treeton (seven out of ten)
- Where a result was achieved, the home side won in 61 games (55%) and the away side in 50 (45%); Appleby Frodingham won most home games (nine out of eleven); and also won most away games (seven out of eight)

#### **Cup Competitions**

#### Viking Cricket Cup (the Yorkshire Premier Leagues Knock-Out Cup)

Appleby Frodingham overcame Driffield in a surprisingly one-sided *Viking Cricket* cup final at Woodhouse Grange on 5 September. Driffield won the toss, elected to bat first, and were bowled out for 126 in the 27th over. The North Yorkshire side were soon 58-6, and only a mini-recovery, inspired by Randeera Ranasingha (27), helped them reach three figures. Man-of-the-match Paul Hilton took 3-11 in 6.3 overs. #### **ExtraCover Insurance Whitworth Cup**

After electing to bat first, Sprotbrough posted 213-3 in their 40 overs, thanks to a brilliant second-wicket stand of 147 between Gordon Thomson (87) and Dean Williamson (78 not out off 85 balls) and some excellent running between the wickets. In reply, Aston Hall were soon 24-2, but Josh Coulson (63 off 85 balls) pulled his side into contention at 153-5. ## HALL OF FAME



The Hall of Fame was introduced by the Yorkshire South Premier League to recognise individuals who 'have given outstanding service to our clubs or our league'. The Hall of Fame concept has been taken on board by the Yorkshire Cricket Southern Premier League, and future inductions will ensure representation from across the whole league. Individuals are inducted into the Hall of Fame each year at the annual presentation dinner.

The existing inductees into the Hall of Fame are:

#### 2017

- 1. **Bill Croft**. Former Sheffield Collegiate seam bowler and tireless committee worker, who became President of the Yorkshire League and is still closely associated with the Collegiate club.
- 2. **Steve Foster**. One of the finest cricketers produced in Yorkshire not to play in the first class game. An outstanding all-rounder for Treeton CC, for whom he continues to play and is now vice-chairman.
- Andy Harrison. Yorkshire League opening bowler with Rotherham before moving to Wickersley, whom he
  captained to seven South Yorkshire titles. Now club groundsman, committee member and founder YSPL
  committee member.
- 4. **Bob Leafe**. Cleethorpes record run scorer, who served the club for over fifty years as player, captain, committee member and, most recently, cricket chairman. He is still actively involved at Chichester Road.
- 5. **Stuart Roberts**. After a playing career spent mainly at Conisborough, he became one of Yorkshire's best umpires in an outstanding umpiring career that included over thirty years on the Premier League panel.
- 6. **Dennis Wadd**. Appleby Frodingham's first team scorer for 54 years; he was a familiar friendly face, a meticulous scorer and an ever-popular figure on grounds across Lincolnshire and Yorkshire.

#### 2018

- 7. **Nick Cowan**. A Yorkshire League legend who led first Rotherham Town and then Doncaster Town to League titles before leading Doncaster to their finest hour, the 1998 National Club Championship. Remains closely involved with DTCC.
- 8. **Keith Haynes**. 'Mr Treeton', whose own playing career with the club was eclipsed by a 31-year tenure as club chairman, during which time he has been the driving force behind making the club what it is today and is still the club groundsman.
- 9. **Richard Wilkinson**. One of South Yorkshire's most popular and talented all-rounders. A stalwart of Barnsley, Whitley Hall and the Yorkshire Academy, his vast experience now benefits the YCB. Now starring with his home club Wombwell Main.

#### 2019

- 10. **Matt Dixon**. Served for 12 years as captain of Sheffield Collegiate CC; a former Yorkshire League committee member who was closely involved in the creation of the YSPL, of which he was vice-chairman for three years.
- 11. **Harry Fidler**. An ever popular and respected 'old school' umpire who served 16 years on the Yorkshire Premier Leagues panel and is now on the League panel; Harry rarely, if ever, refuses any appointment.
- 12. **Kevin Motley**. A dedicated and meticulous scorer for Barnsley for many seasons, recognised as one of the best in the country, and founder of this Almanac; now sadly retired from scoring due to ill health but continues to support the League with his advice and knowledge.
