Distribution of ECB monies 2023

- 1 **Split of total money received**. This will remain as for 2022 funding:
 - i. 60% of funding will be available for Premier Division clubs, subject to their meeting the criteria 2 below.
 - ii. 30% of funding will Championship Division clubs, subject to their meeting the criteria 2 below. (a maximum of 1/12th of the 30% available for each club **without** a first team in Premier division)
 - iii. 10% to League funds for administration and other expenditure
 - iv. any money not allocated under i and ii above to go to the Development Fund for Senior Section clubs
- 2 Premier Section club allocations. These will be as follows:
 - i. *pitch markings* (25% of available pot) a full share is awarded where the average mark is at least 15/20 and a half share for at least 14/20;
 - ii. outfield markings (25% of pot) a full share is awarded where the average mark is at least 3.75/5 and a half for at least 3.5/5
 - iii. *facilities* (10% of pot) to be awarded unless any significant failures or shortcomings are identified during the season
 - iv. All Stars/Dynamos or similar club programme (10% of pot) must run, and must achieve at least 80% of the participation achieved in the previous season full share where fully met, and a half share where within 10%
 - v. Junior players in senior cricket (10% of pot) over the course of the season, the average number of games played by any players under 21 years old in the club's first and second teams together, must be at least five per game played full share where fully met, and a half share where average above 4.5.
 - vi. Womens' & girls' participation (10% of pot) must have a W&G section and at least one soft or hard ball team playing in the SYW&GCL or similar league half share where there is a W&G section only.
 - vii. Use of injury surveillance reporting tool (5% of pot) must be used to report any injuries.
 - viii. Anti-discrimination training (5% of pot) at least six club officials, including the chairman and secretary, to have completed online training.

In addition, where any club does not field three junior hardball teams, in line with the ECB Premier League requirement, a further 10% of their available pot will be withheld.
